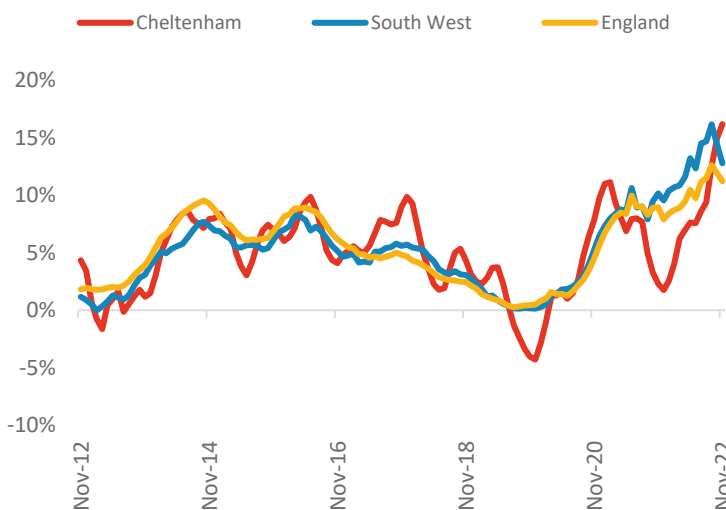

Annual Change in House Prices

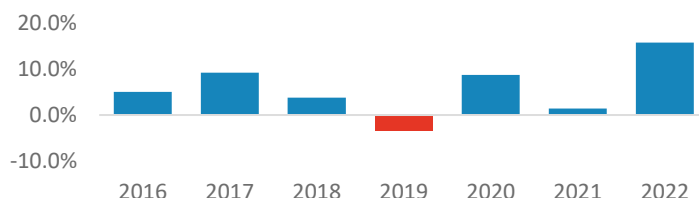


House prices in Cheltenham grew by 16.2% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the South West grew by 12.8% over the same period.

Cheltenham house prices are now 64.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +59.2% for the South West and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 15.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 1.5% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

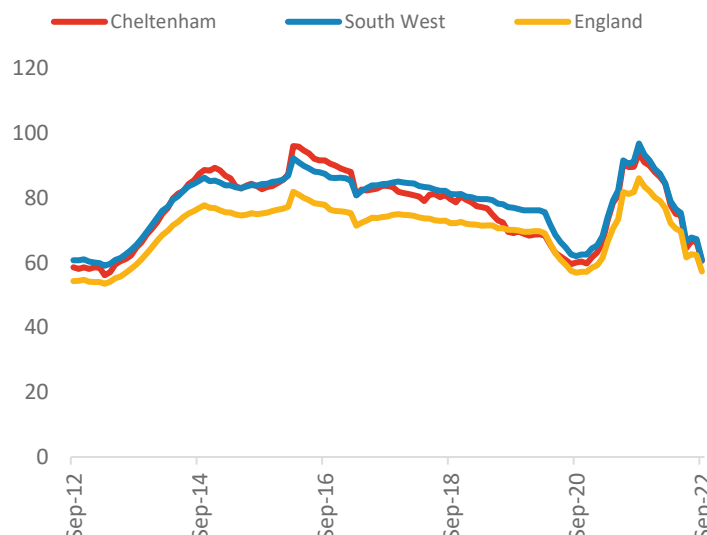


Transactions (September 2022 data)

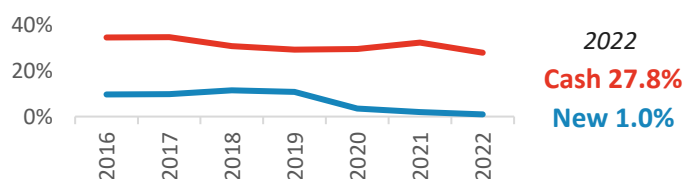
There were 1,808 transactions in Cheltenham during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 60% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Cheltenham have fallen by 32.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -28.7% for the South West and -25.4% for England.
