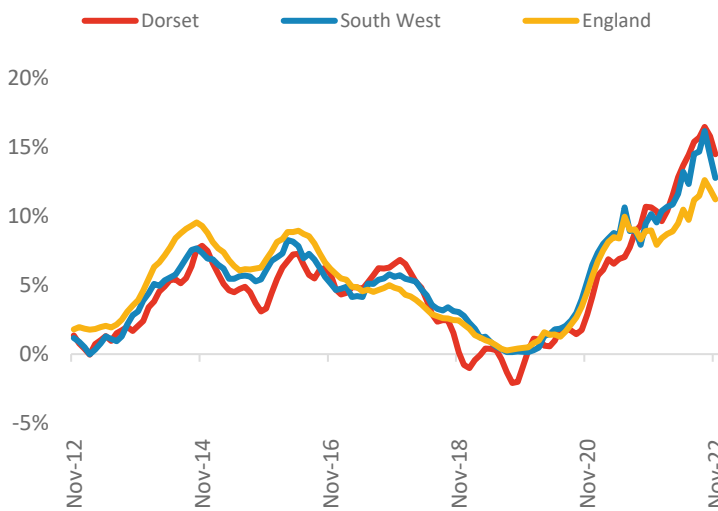

### House Prices (November 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

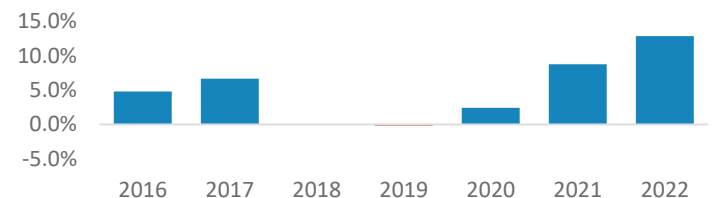


House prices in Dorset grew by 14.5% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the South West grew by 12.8% over the same period.

Dorset house prices are now 52.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +59.2% for the South West and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 12.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 8.8% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

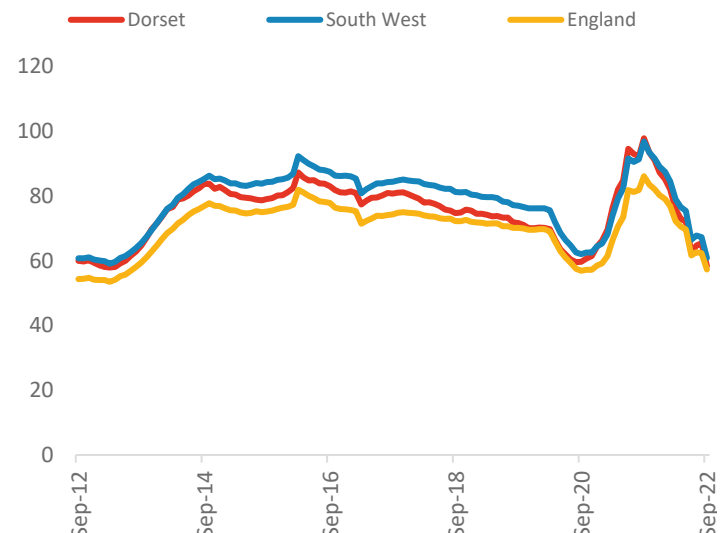


### Transactions (September 2022 data)

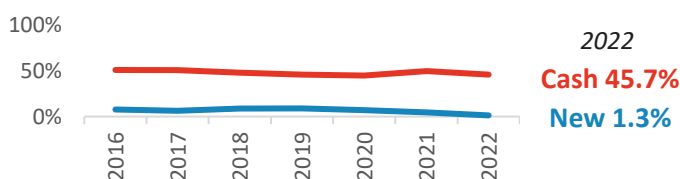
There were 5,342 transactions in Dorset during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 58% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Dorset have fallen by 29.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -28.7% for the South West and -25.4% for England.
