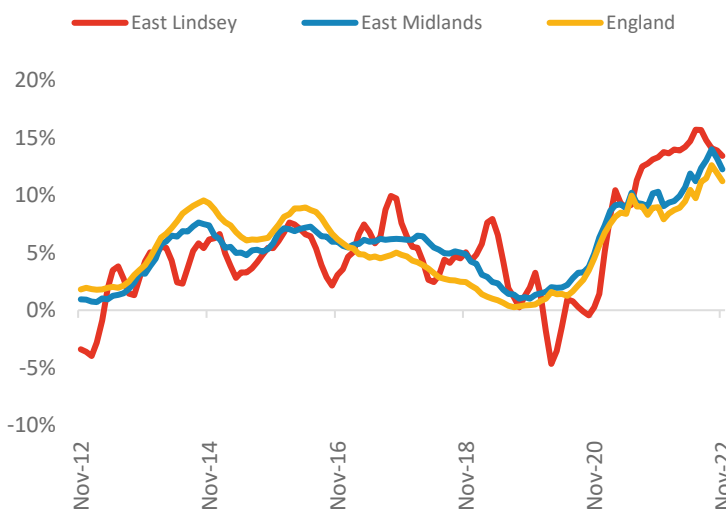

Annual Change in House Prices

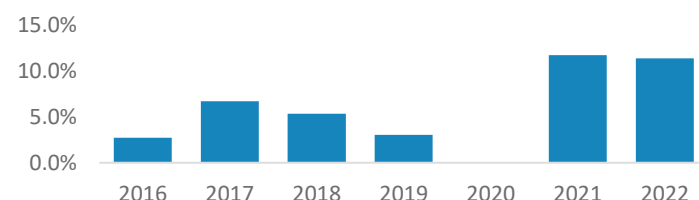


House prices in East Lindsey grew by 13.4% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 12.3% over the same period.

East Lindsey house prices are now 47.4% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +59.4% for the East Midlands and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 11.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 11.8% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

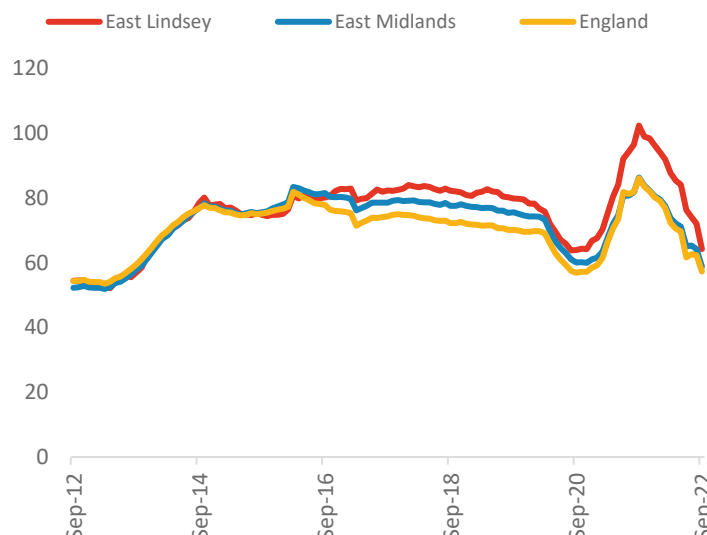


Transactions (September 2022 data)

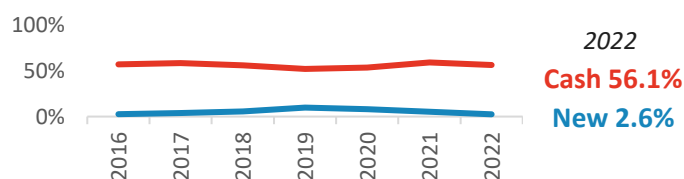
There were 2,081 transactions in East Lindsey during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 64% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in East Lindsey have fallen by 17.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -24.0% for the East Midlands and -25.4% for England.
