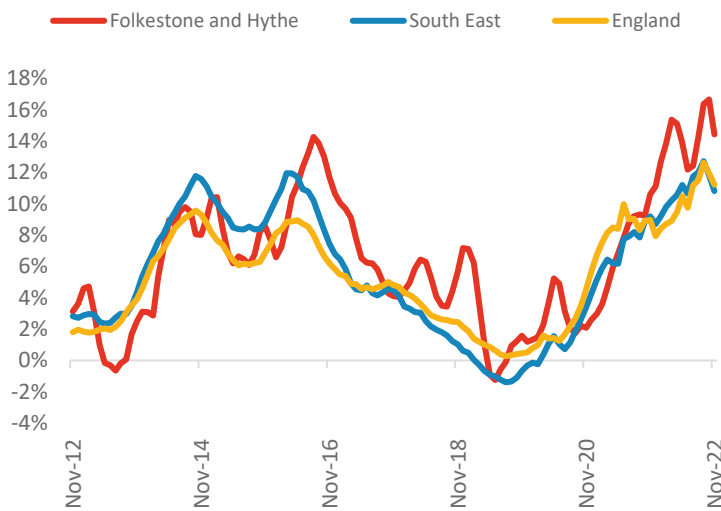

### House Prices (November 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

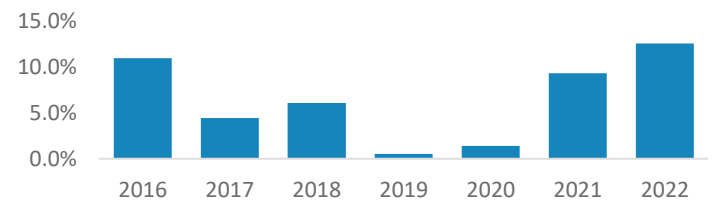


House prices in Folkestone and Hythe grew by 14.4% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the South East grew by 10.8% over the same period.

Folkestone and Hythe house prices are now 69.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +69.2% for the South East and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 12.6% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 9.3% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

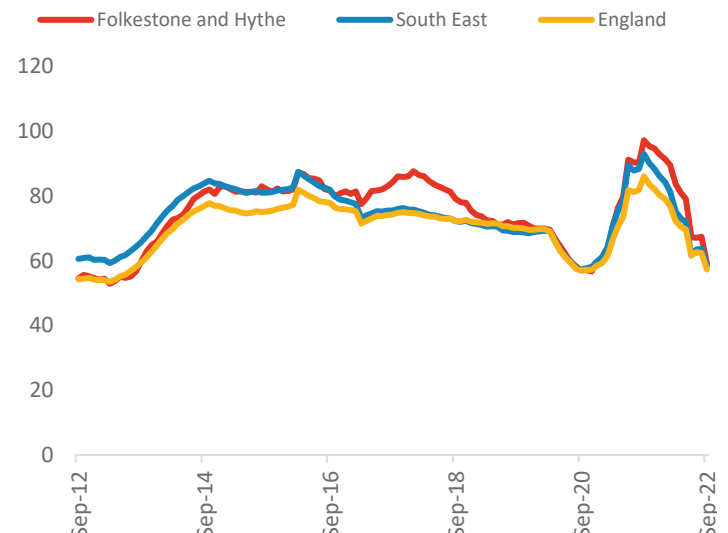


### Transactions (September 2022 data)

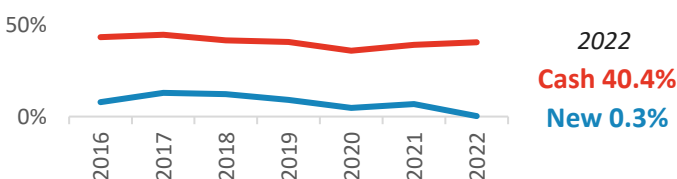
There were 1,600 transactions in Folkestone and Hythe during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 59% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Folkestone and Hythe have fallen by 28.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -30.2% for the South East and -25.4% for England.
