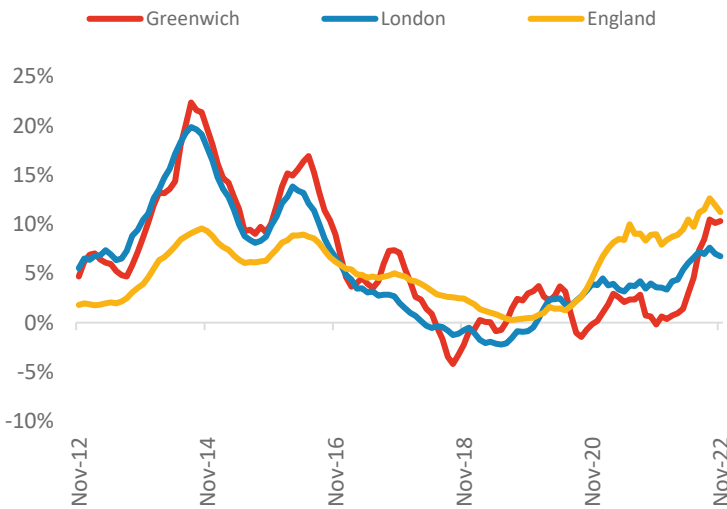

### House Prices (November 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

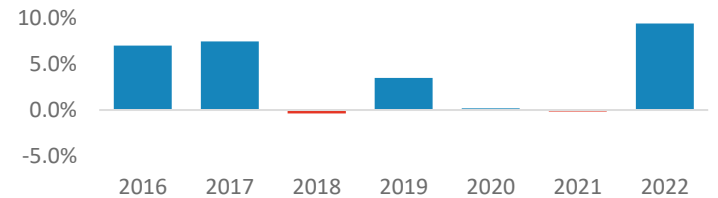


House prices in Greenwich grew by 10.3% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in London grew by 6.7% over the same period.

Greenwich house prices are now 84.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +82.2% for London and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 9.4% in 2022 so far, compared to a fall of 0.2% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

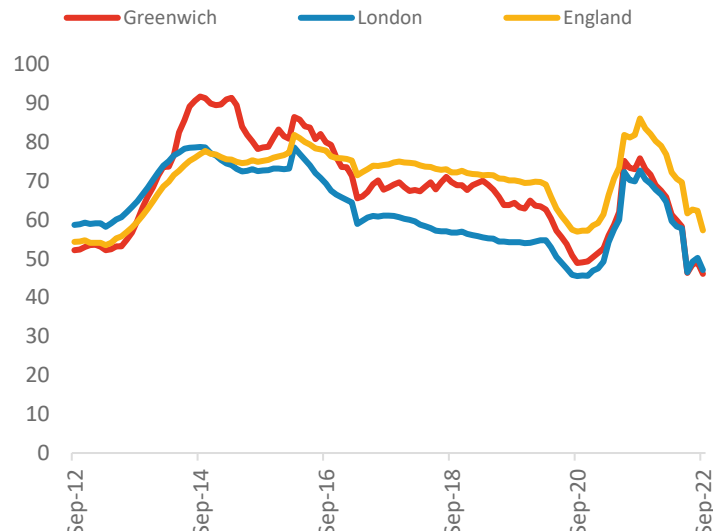


### Transactions (September 2022 data)

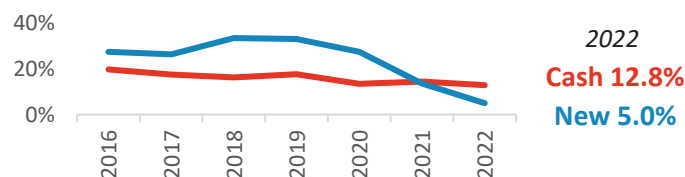
There were 2,382 transactions in Greenwich during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 46% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Greenwich have fallen by 48.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -38.5% for London and -25.4% for England.
