

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Hart grew by 11.3% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the South East grew by 10.8% over the same period.

Hart house prices are now 70.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +69.2% for the South East and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 10.1% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 6.6% over the same period last year.



Transactions (September 2022 data)


There were 1,347 transactions in Hart during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 58% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100) levels.

Transactions in Hart have fallen by 21.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -30.2% for the South East and -25.4% for England.
