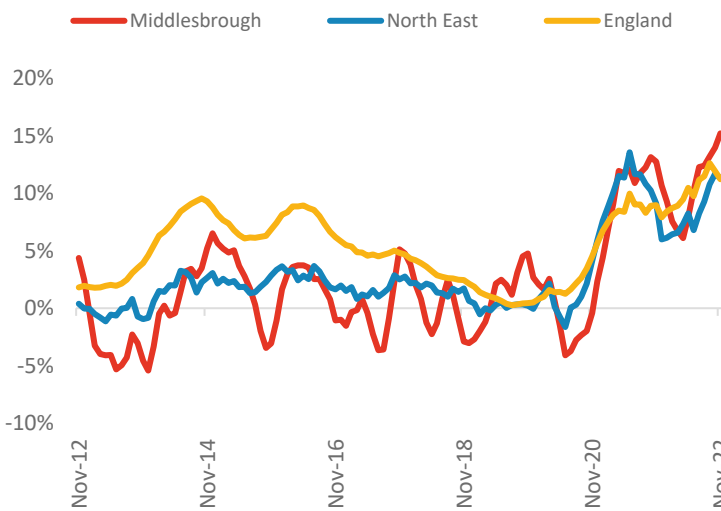

Annual Change in House Prices

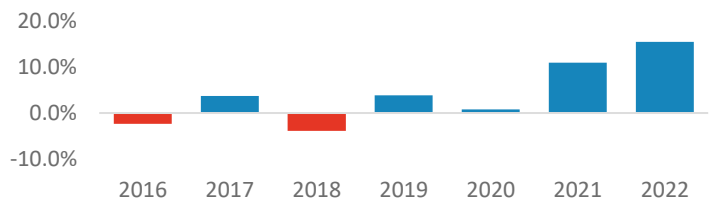


House prices in Middlesbrough grew by 15.2% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the North East grew by 11.3% over the same period.

Middlesbrough house prices are now 16.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +18.7% for the North East and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 15.6% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 11.0% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

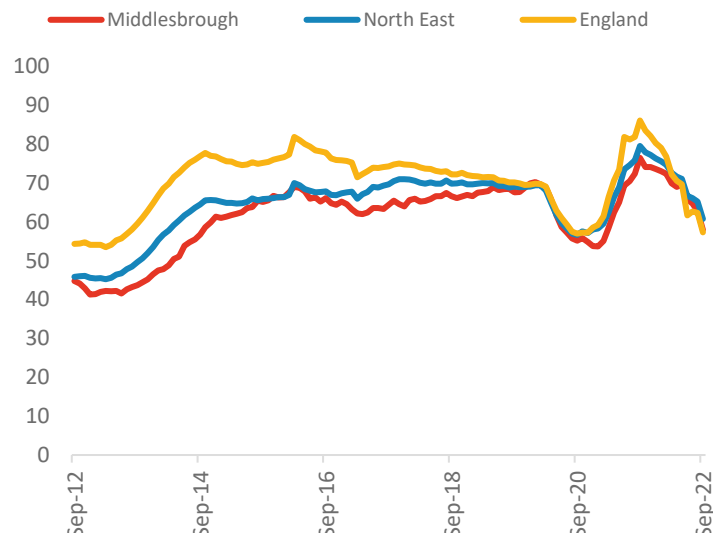


Transactions (September 2022 data)

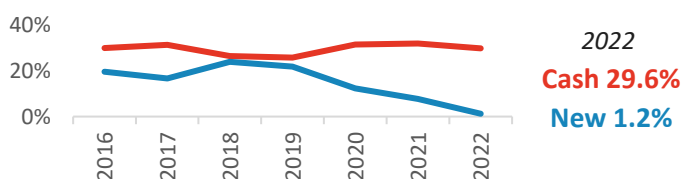
There were 1,683 transactions in Middlesbrough during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 58% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Middlesbrough have fallen by 5.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -7.3% for the North East and -25.4% for England.
