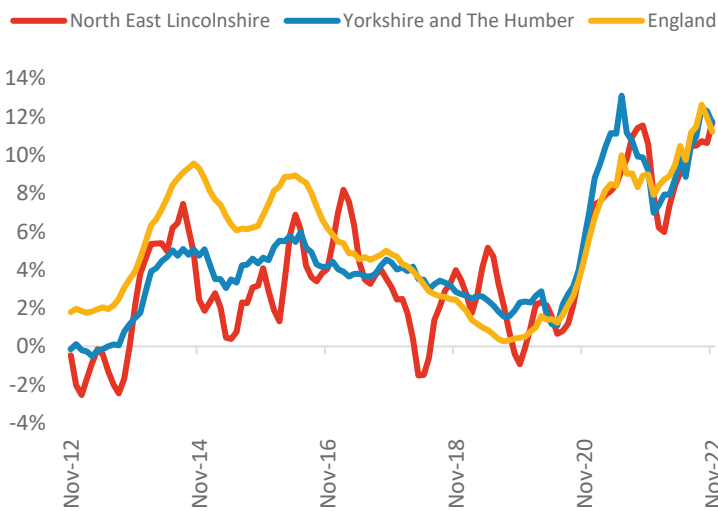

Annual Change in House Prices

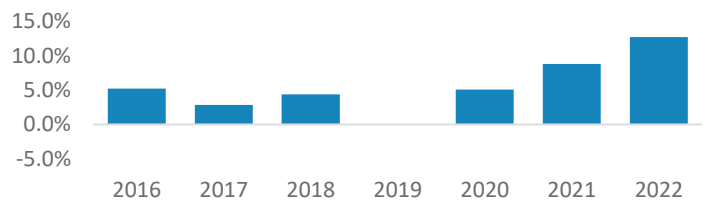


House prices in North East Lincolnshire grew by 11.7% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 11.7% over the same period.

North East Lincolnshire house prices are now 31.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 12.8% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 8.8% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

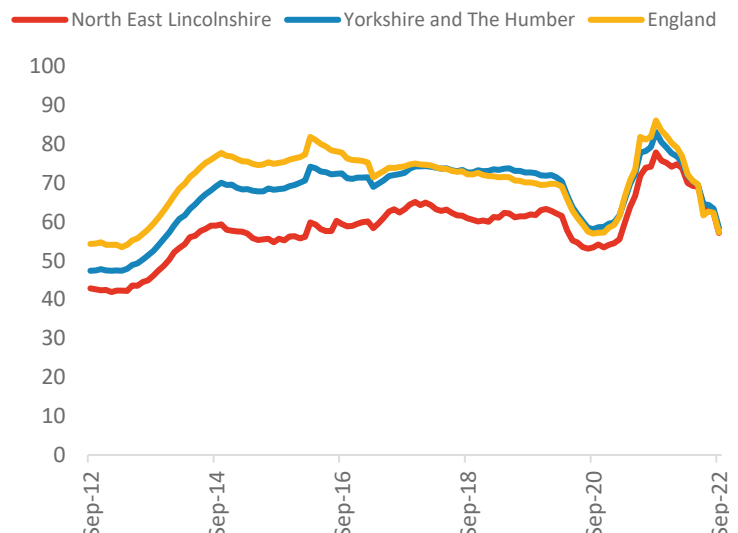


Transactions (September 2022 data)

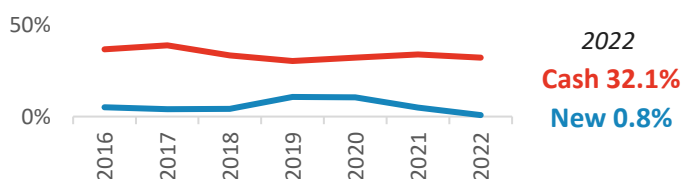
There were 2,356 transactions in North East Lincolnshire during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 57% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in North East Lincolnshire have fallen by 1.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -16.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -25.4% for England.
