

Annual Change in House Prices






There were 4,444 transactions in Northumberland during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 63% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Northumberland have fallen by 10.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -7.3% for the North East and -25.4% for England.


Note: These transaction counts do not include those identified as transfers under a power of sale/repossessions, buy-to-lets (where they can be identified by a mortgage), and transfers to non-private individuals.

House prices in Northumberland grew by 14.2% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the North East grew by 11.3% over the same period.

Northumberland house prices are now 23.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +18.7% for the North East and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 15.0% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 5.4% over the same period last year.
