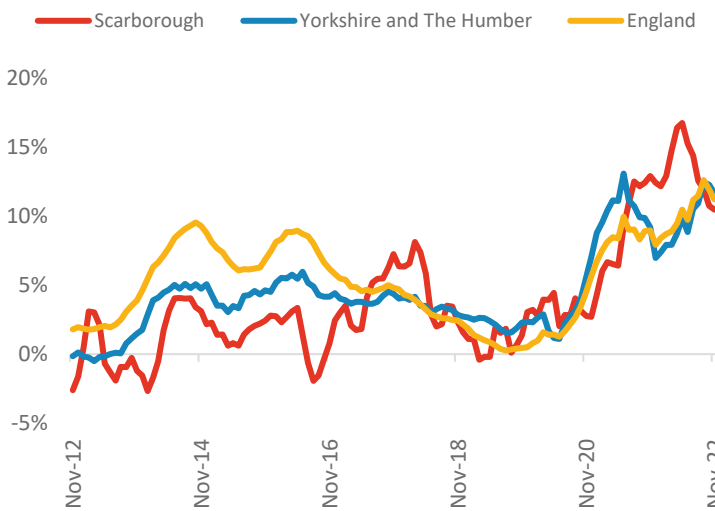

Annual Change in House Prices

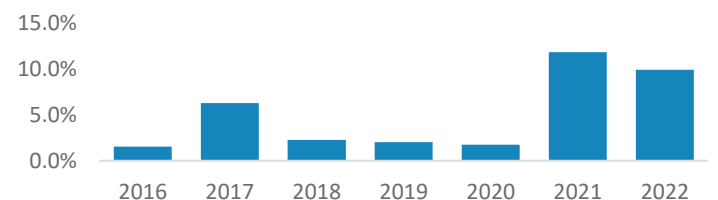


House prices in Scarborough grew by 10.5% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 11.7% over the same period.

Scarborough house prices are now 26.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 9.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 11.9% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

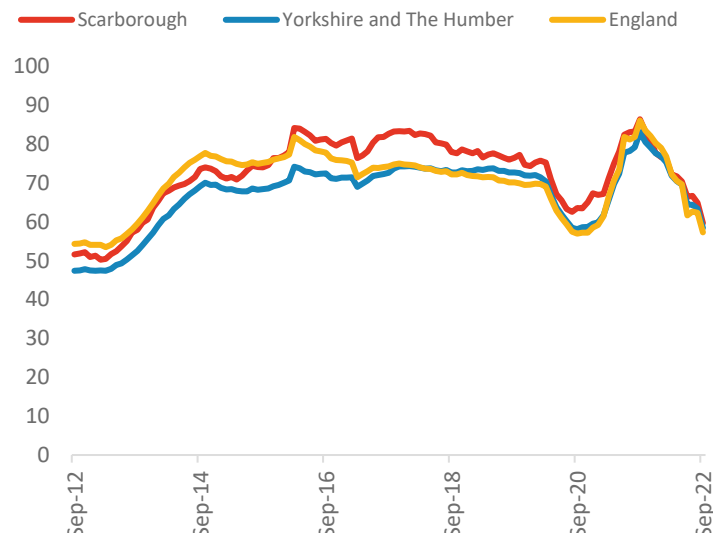


Transactions (September 2022 data)

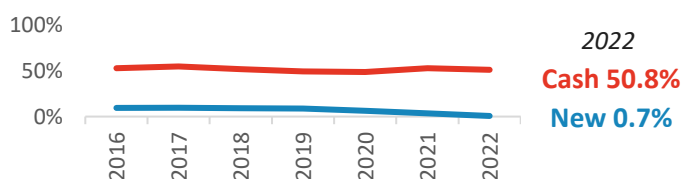
There were 1,760 transactions in Scarborough during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 60% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Scarborough have fallen by 18.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -16.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -25.4% for England.
