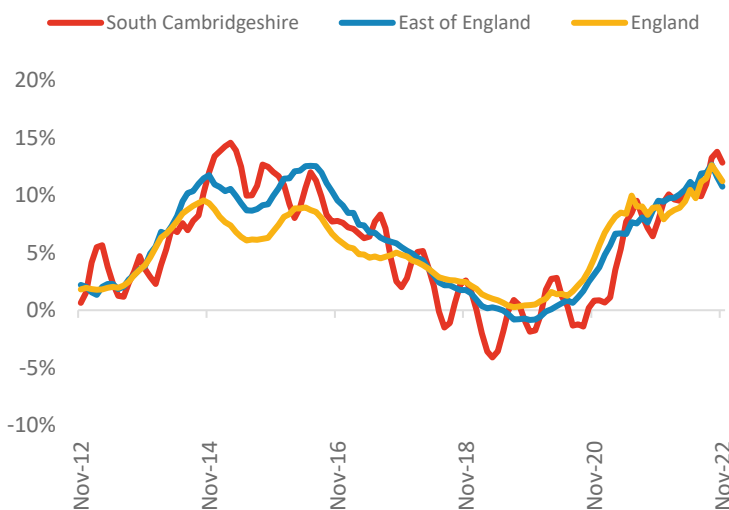

House Prices (November 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in South Cambridgeshire grew by 12.9% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the East of England grew by 10.8% over the same period.

South Cambridgeshire house prices are now 73.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +73.7% for the East of England and +61.9% across England.

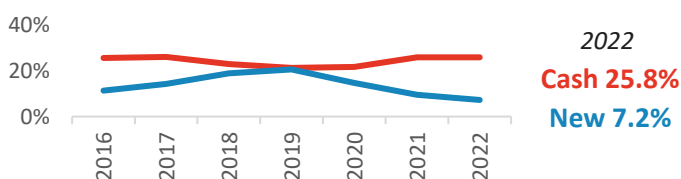
Local prices have grown by 11.3% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 7.9% over the same period last year.

Transactions (September 2022 data)

There were 1,841 transactions in South Cambridgeshire during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in South Cambridgeshire have fallen by 36.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -31.1% for the East of England and -25.4% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

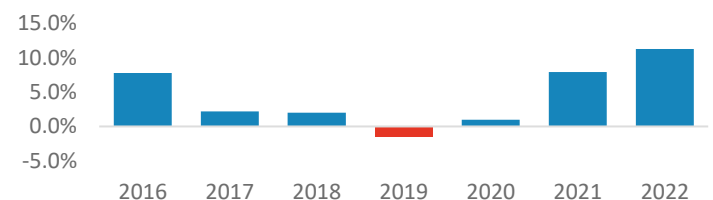
