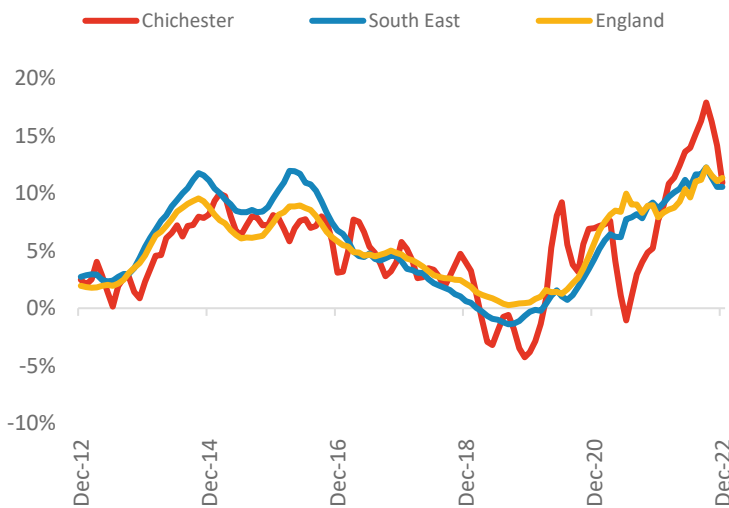

### House Prices (December 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Chichester grew by 10.9% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the South East grew by 10.6% over the same period.

Chichester house prices are now 66.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +69.1% for the South East and +61.9% across England.

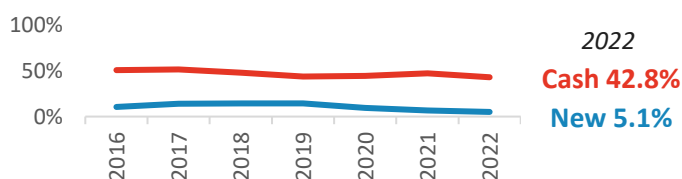
Local prices have grown by 10.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 7.7% over the same period last year.

### Transactions (October 2022 data)

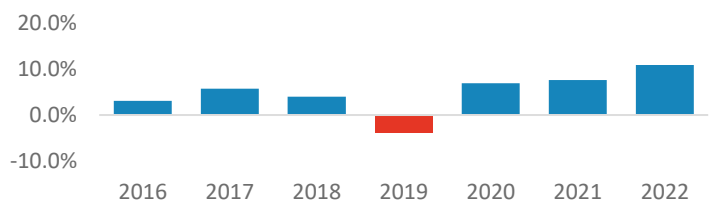
There were 1,679 transactions in Chichester during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 67% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Chichester have fallen by 29.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -27.5% for the South East and -22.8% for England.

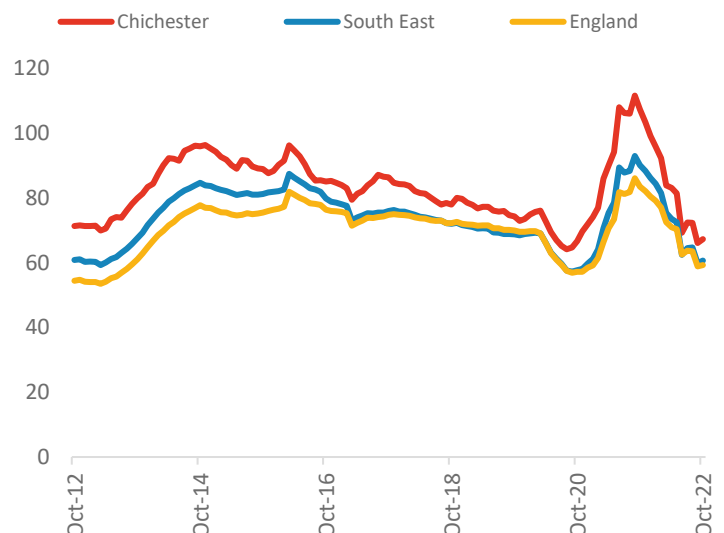
#### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year\*
