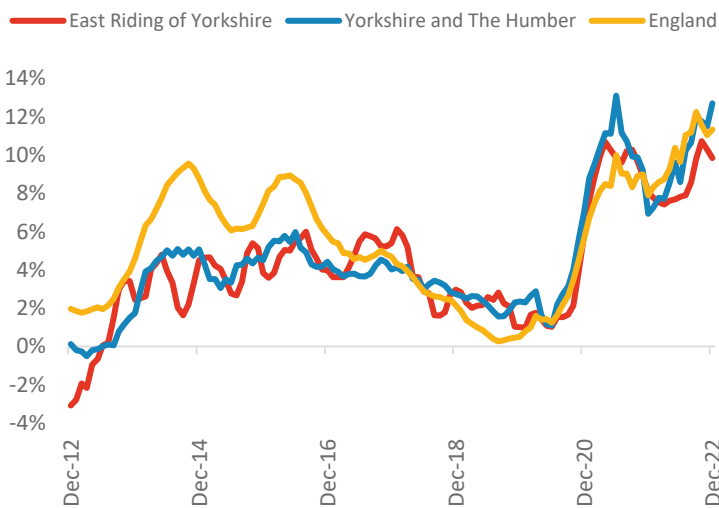

Annual Change in House Prices

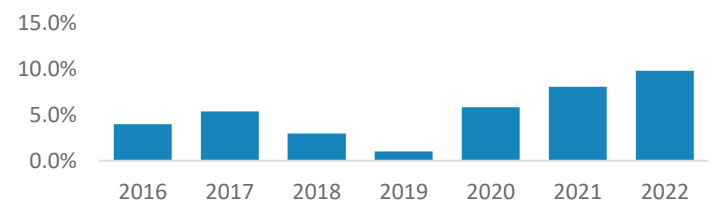


House prices in East Riding of Yorkshire grew by 9.8% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 12.7% over the same period.

East Riding of Yorkshire house prices are now 38.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.3% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 9.8% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 8.1% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

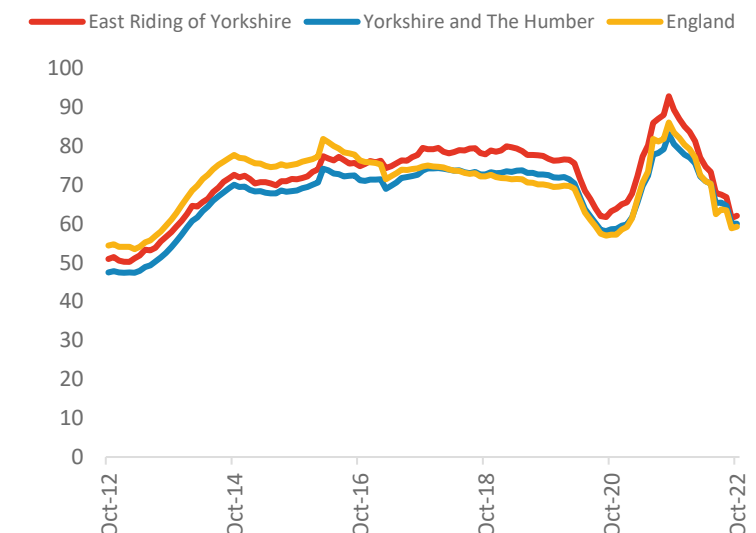


Transactions (October 2022 data)

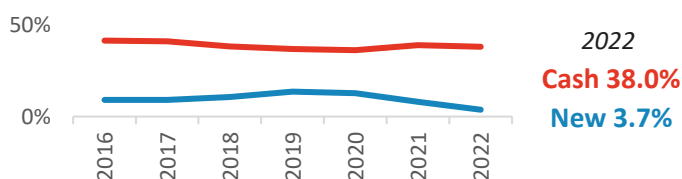
There were 5,349 transactions in East Riding of Yorkshire during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in East Riding of Yorkshire have fallen by 14.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -13.8% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -22.8% for England.
