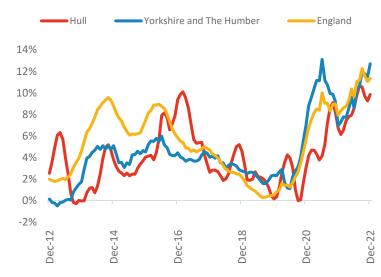

Annual Change in House Prices

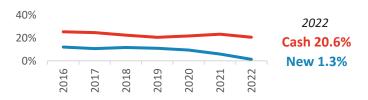


Transactions (October 2022 data)

There were 3,236 transactions in Hull during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 54% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Hull have fallen by 7.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -13.8% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -22.8% for England.

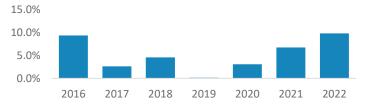
Note: These transaction counts do not include those identified as transfers under a power of sale/repossessions, buy-to-lets (where they can be identified by a mortgage), and transfers to non-private individuals.

House prices in Hull grew by 9.8% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 12.7% over the same period.

Hull house prices are now 36.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.3% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 9.8% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 6.8% over the same period last year.
