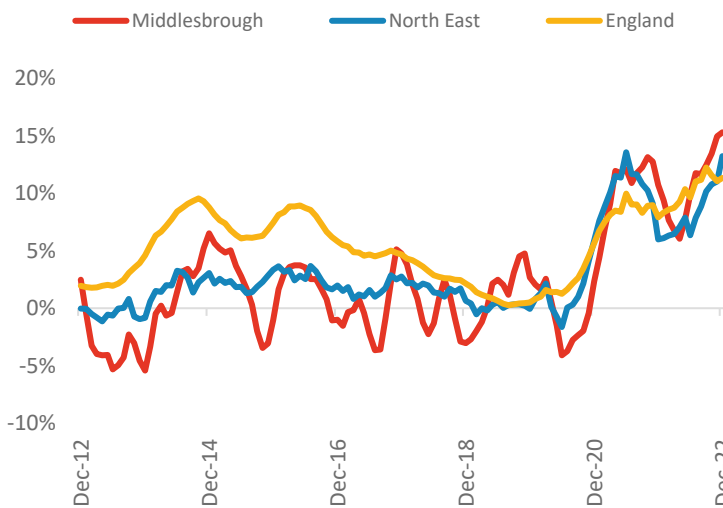

### House Prices (December 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

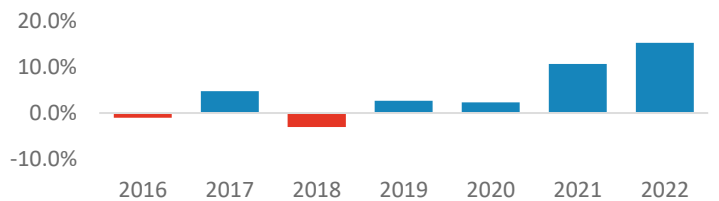


House prices in Middlesbrough grew by 15.3% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the North East grew by 13.2% over the same period.

Middlesbrough house prices are now 16.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +18.5% for the North East and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 15.3% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 10.7% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

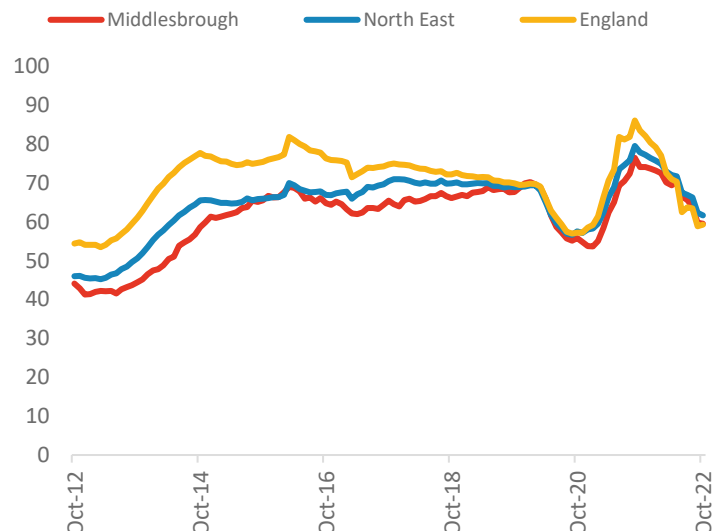


### Transactions (October 2022 data)

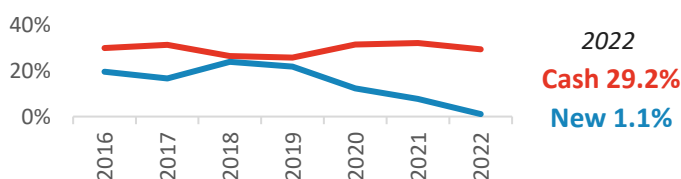
There were 1,729 transactions in Middlesbrough during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 59% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Middlesbrough have fallen by 2.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -5.9% for the North East and -22.8% for England.
