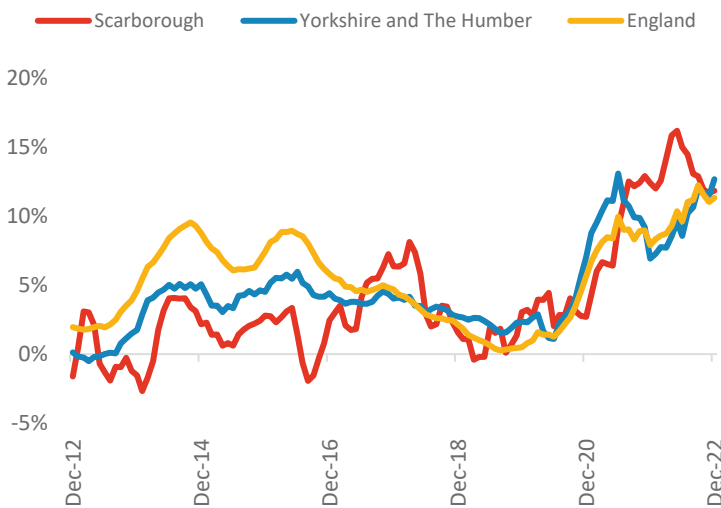

### House Prices (December 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

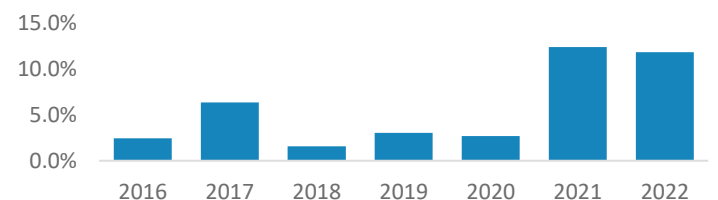


House prices in Scarborough grew by 11.9% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 12.7% over the same period.

Scarborough house prices are now 28.4% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.3% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 11.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 12.4% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

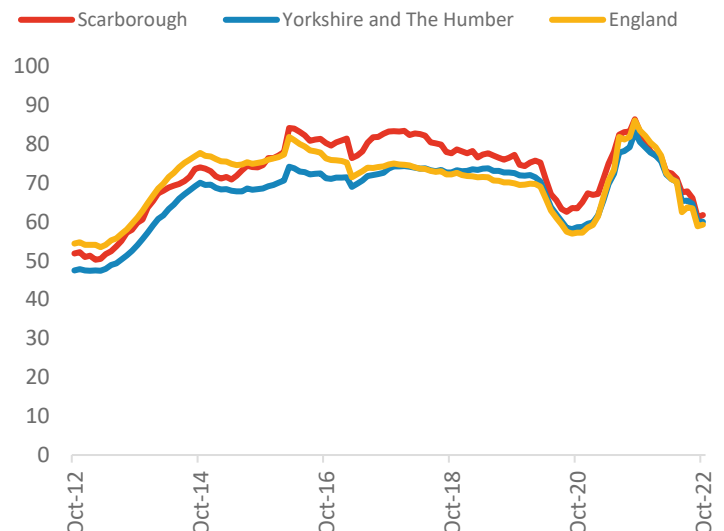


### Transactions (October 2022 data)

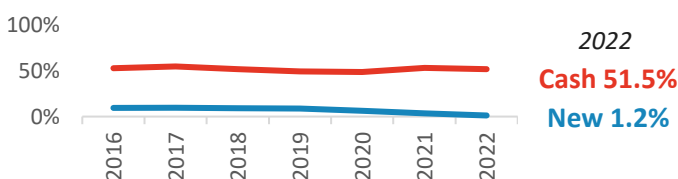
There were 1,821 transactions in Scarborough during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Scarborough have fallen by 15.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -13.8% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -22.8% for England.
