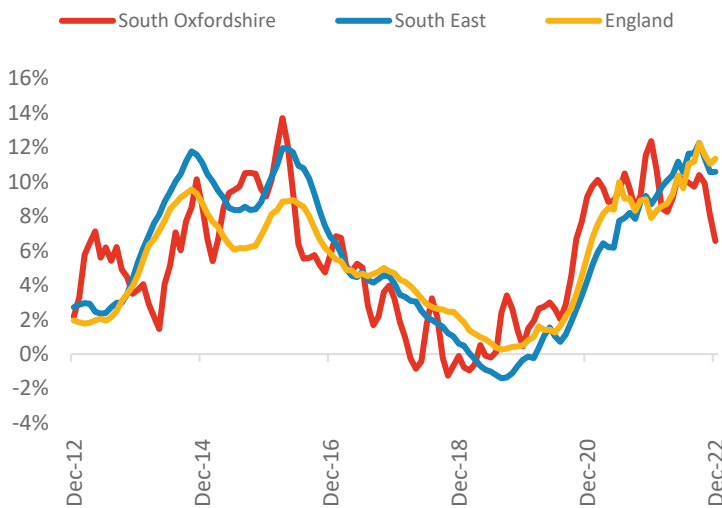

### House Prices (December 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

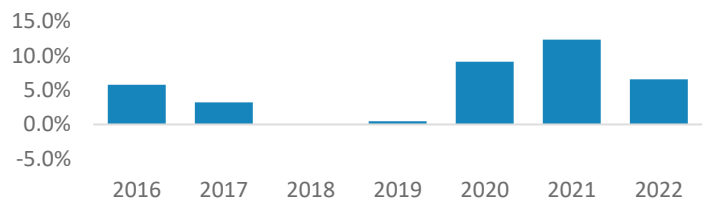


House prices in South Oxfordshire grew by 6.6% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the South East grew by 10.6% over the same period.

South Oxfordshire house prices are now 71.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +69.1% for the South East and +61.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 6.6% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 12.4% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

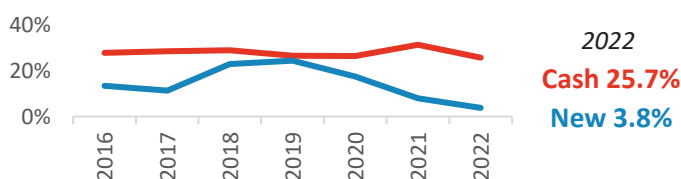


### Transactions (October 2022 data)

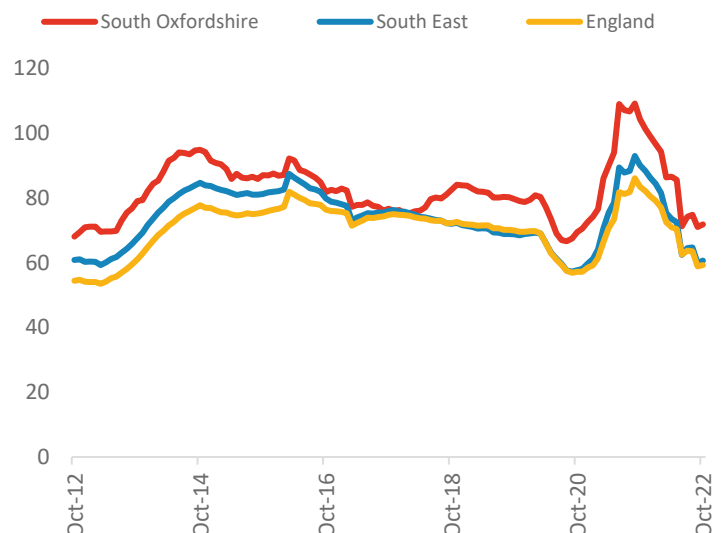
There were 2,088 transactions in South Oxfordshire during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 72% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in South Oxfordshire have fallen by 21.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -27.5% for the South East and -22.8% for England.
