

House Prices (December 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in West Devon grew by 6.9% in the 12 months to December 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the South West grew by 11.6% over the same period.

West Devon house prices are now 41.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +58.0% for the South West and +61.9% across England.


Local prices have grown by 6.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 15.7% over the same period last year.

Transactions (October 2022 data)


There were 777 transactions in West Devon during the 12 months to October 2022. This is 68% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below predownturn levels.

Transactions in West Devon have fallen by 23.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -25.8% for the South West and -22.8% for England.
