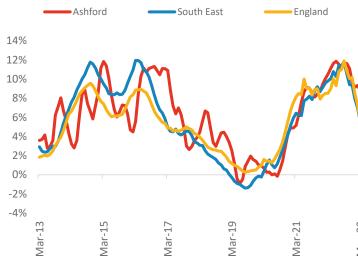

House Prices (March 2023 data)

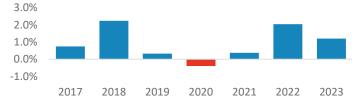
Annual Change in House Prices

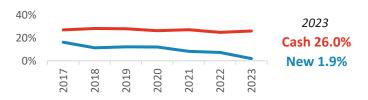

Transactions (January 2023 data)

There were 1,815 transactions in Ashford during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 61% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below predownturn levels.

Transactions in Ashford have fallen by 19.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.9% for the South East and -22.4% for England.
