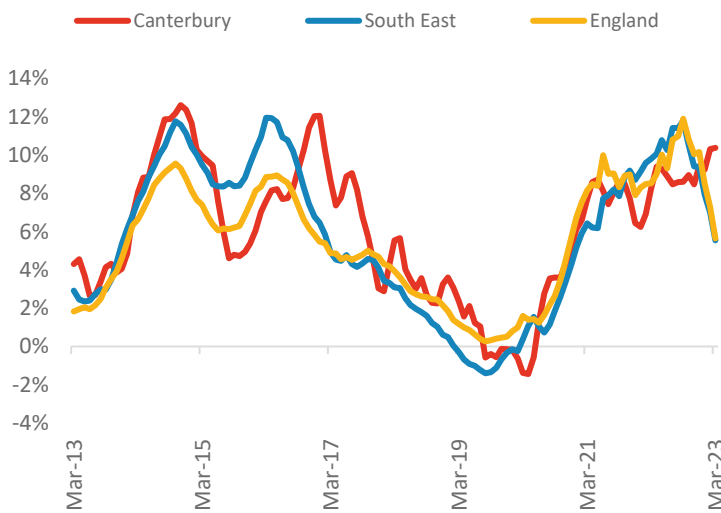

Annual Change in House Prices

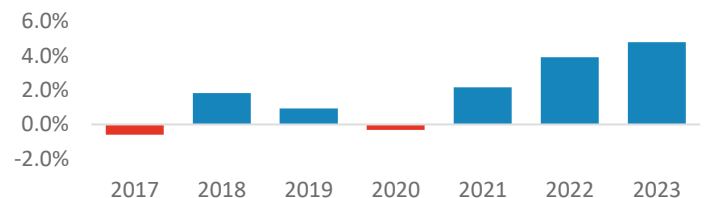


House prices in Canterbury grew by 10.4% in the 12 months to March 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 5.6% and prices in the South East grew by 5.5% over the same period.

Canterbury house prices are now 81.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +66.0% for the South East and +57.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.8% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 3.9% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to March

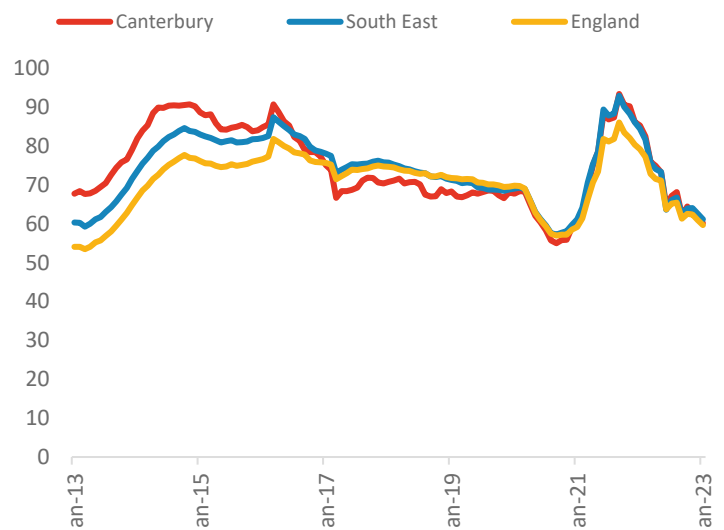


Transactions (January 2023 data)

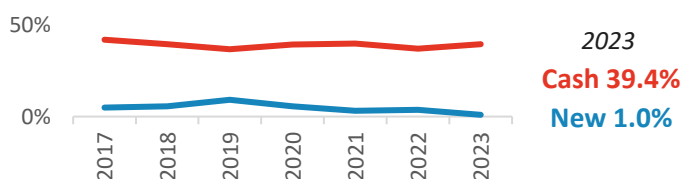
There were 2,071 transactions in Canterbury during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 60% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Canterbury have fallen by 33.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.9% for the South East and -22.4% for England.
