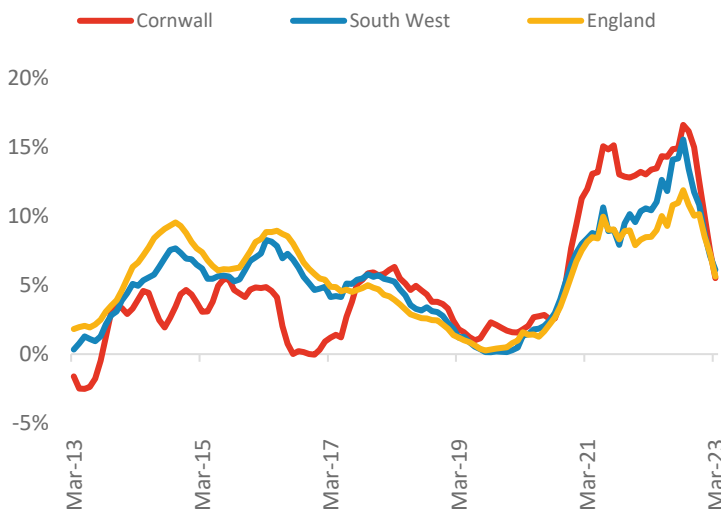

### House Prices (March 2023 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

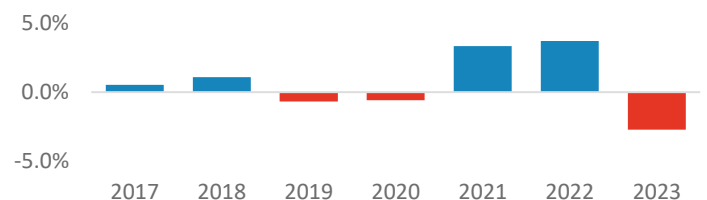


House prices in Cornwall grew by 5.5% in the 12 months to March 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 5.6% and prices in the South West grew by 6.1% over the same period.

Cornwall house prices are now 45.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +54.5% for the South West and +57.9% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 2.7% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 3.7% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to March

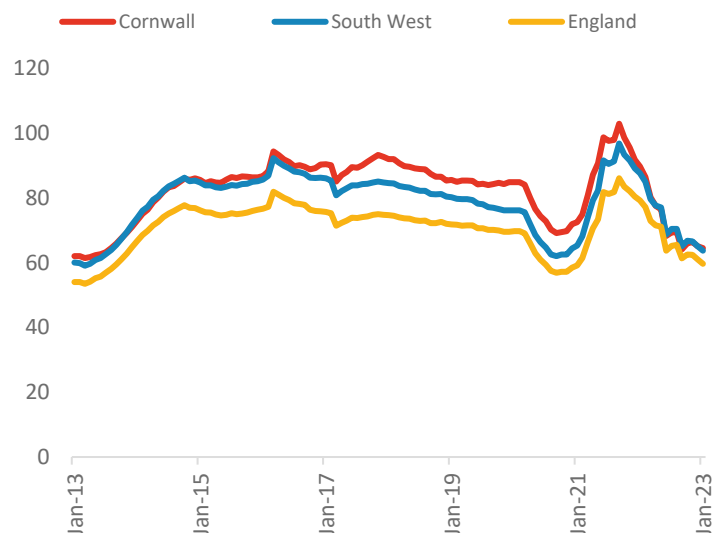


### Transactions (January 2023 data)

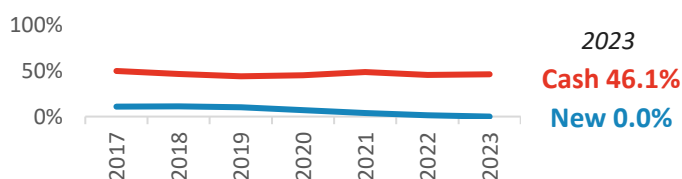
There were 7,839 transactions in Cornwall during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 64% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Cornwall have fallen by 25.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -25.4% for the South West and -22.4% for England.
