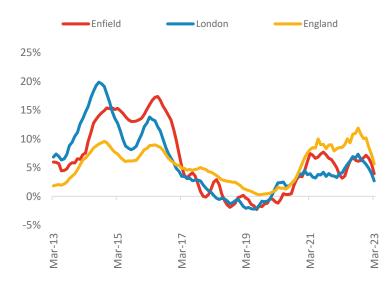

House Prices (March 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Enfield grew by 4.0% in the 12 months to March 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 5.6% and prices in London grew by 2.7% over the same period.

Enfield house prices are now 75.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +77.9% for London and +57.9% across England.

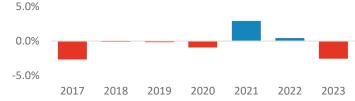
Local prices have fallen by 2.6% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 0.4% over the same period last year.

Transactions (January 2023 data)

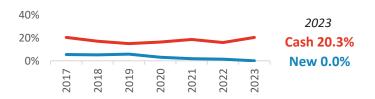
There were 2,560 transactions in Enfield during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 40% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below predownturn levels.

Transactions in Enfield have fallen by 34.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -33.0% for London and -22.4% for England.
