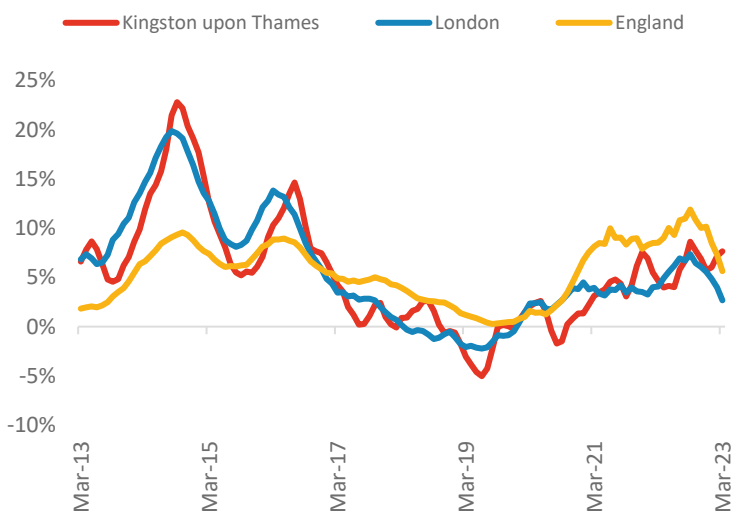

Annual Change in House Prices

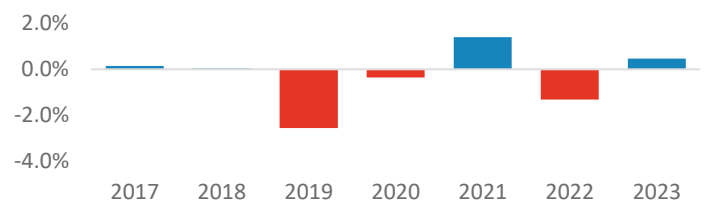


House prices in Kingston upon Thames grew by 7.7% in the 12 months to March 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 5.6% and prices in London grew by 2.7% over the same period.

Kingston upon Thames house prices are now 74.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +77.9% for London and +57.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.5% in 2023 so far, compared to a fall of 1.3% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to March

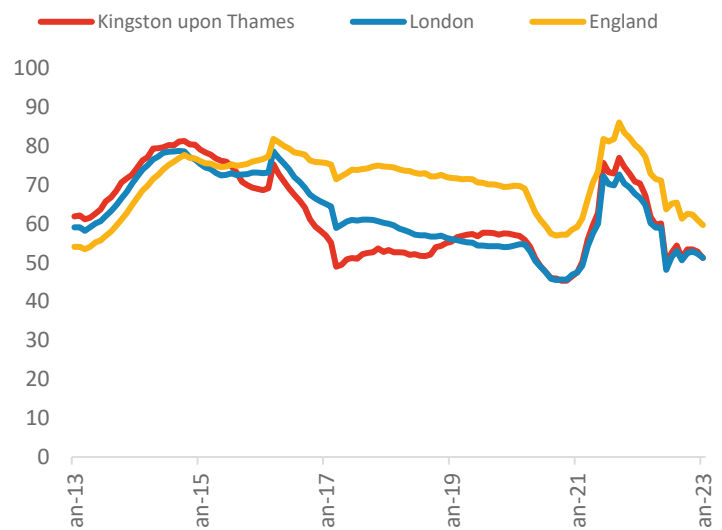


Transactions (January 2023 data)

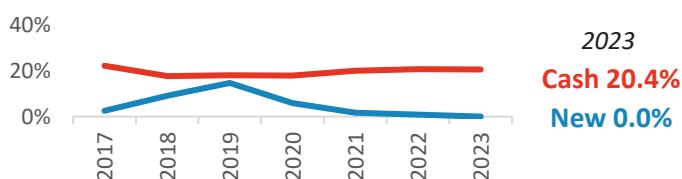
There were 1,949 transactions in Kingston upon Thames during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 51% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Kingston upon Thames have fallen by 36.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -33.0% for London and -22.4% for England.
