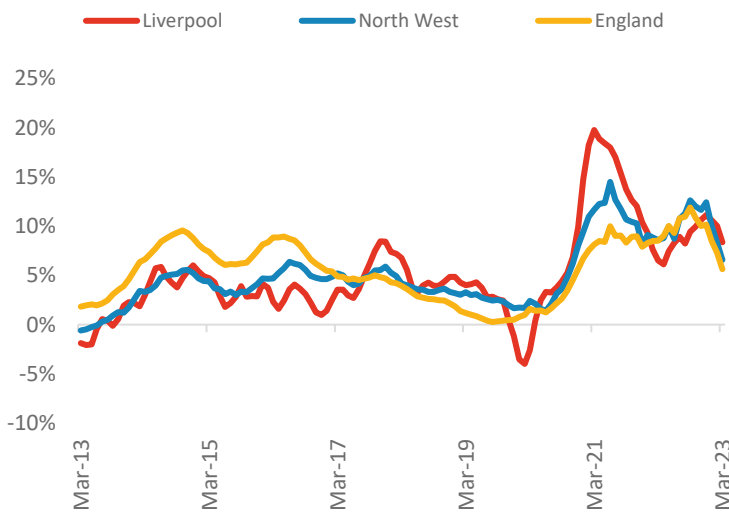

House Prices (March 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Liverpool grew by 8.4% in the 12 months to March 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 5.6% and prices in the North West grew by 6.6% over the same period.

Liverpool house prices are now 38.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +41.1% for the North West and +57.9% across England.

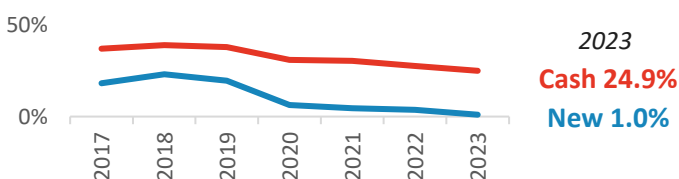
Local prices have fallen by 0.4% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 2.1% over the same period last year.

Transactions (January 2023 data)

There were 5,213 transactions in Liverpool during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 58% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Liverpool have fallen by 11.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -10.4% for the North West and -22.4% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

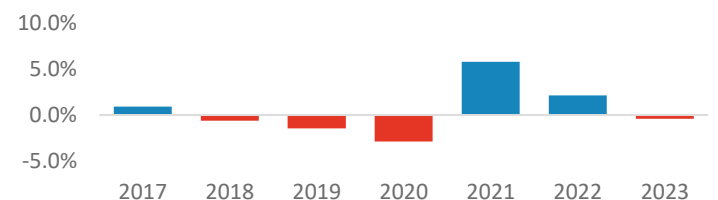
