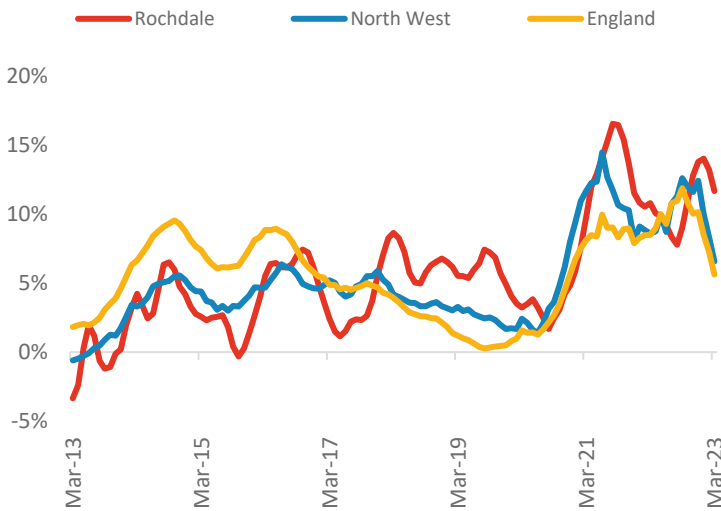

Annual Change in House Prices

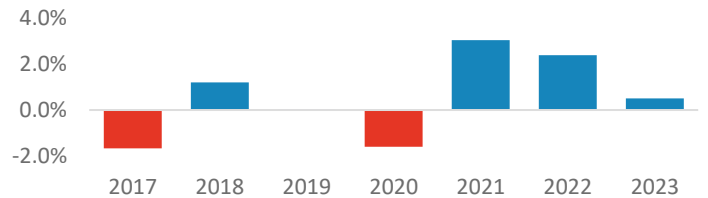


House prices in Rochdale grew by 11.7% in the 12 months to March 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 5.6% and prices in the North West grew by 6.6% over the same period.

Rochdale house prices are now 44.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +41.1% for the North West and +57.9% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.5% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 2.4% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to March

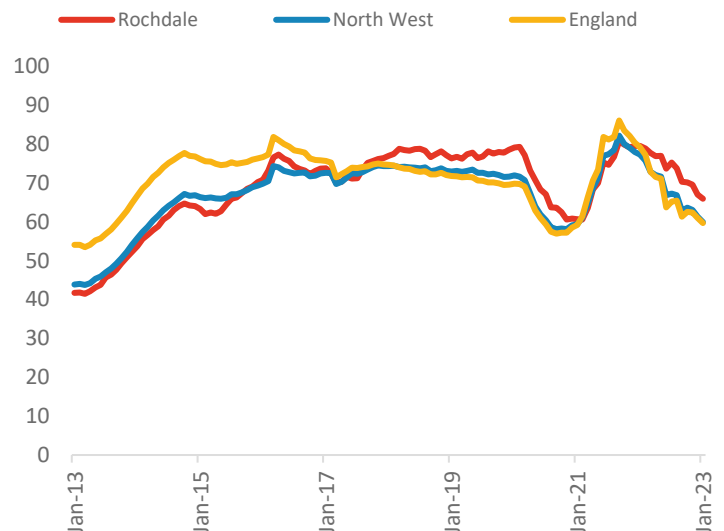


Transactions (January 2023 data)

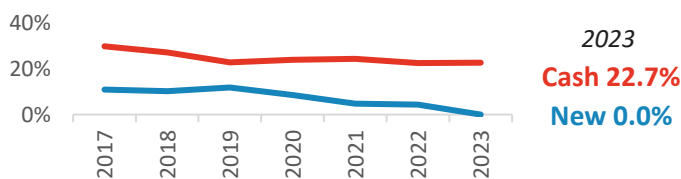
There were 2,620 transactions in Rochdale during the 12 months to January 2023. This is 66% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Rochdale have grown by 2.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -10.4% for the North West and -22.4% for England.
