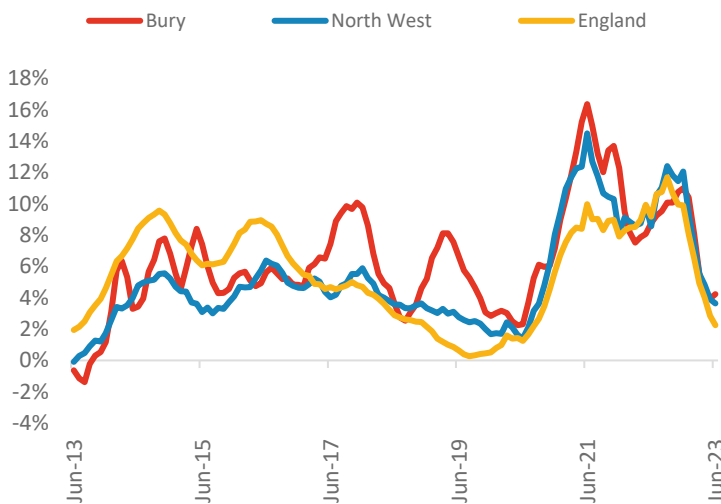

### House Prices (June 2023 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

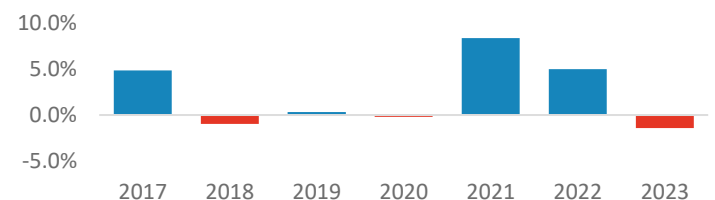


House prices in Bury grew by 4.2% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the North West grew by 3.6% over the same period.

Bury house prices are now 57.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +40.9% for the North West and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 1.4% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 5.0% over the same period last year.

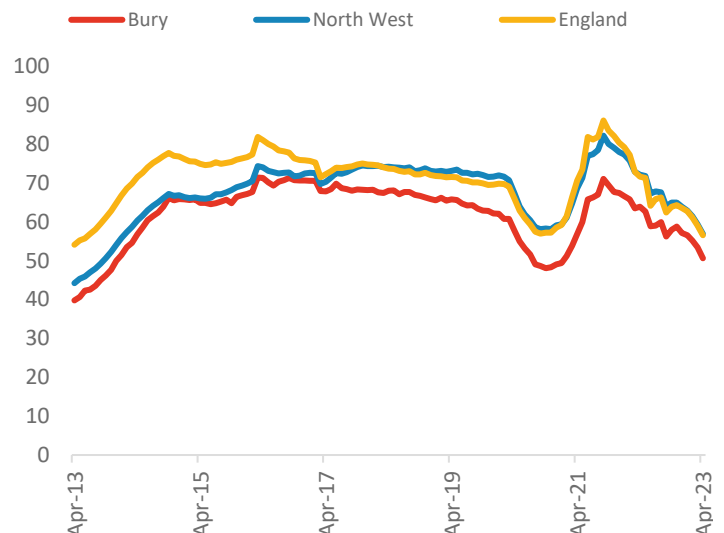
#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to June



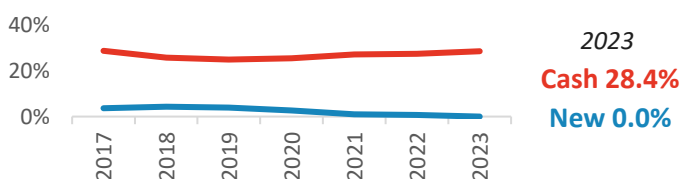
### Transactions (April 2023 data)

There were 2,290 transactions in Bury during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 51% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Bury have fallen by 23.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -15.0% for the North West and -26.4% for England.
