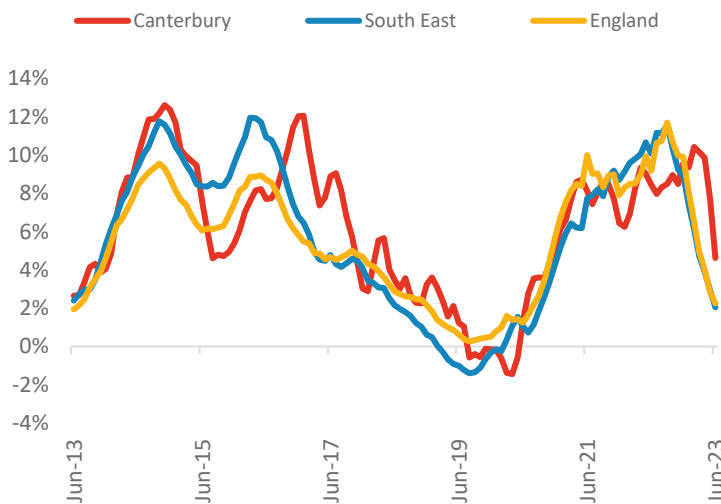

House Prices (June 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Canterbury grew by 4.6% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the South East grew by 2.1% over the same period.

Canterbury house prices are now 76.0% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +63.7% for the South East and +56.6% across England.

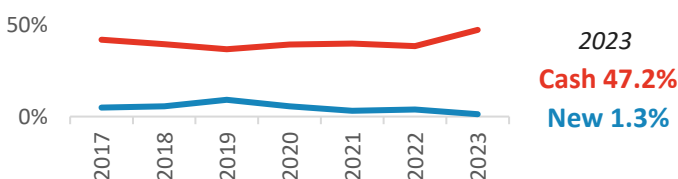
Local prices have grown by 1.7% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 6.6% over the same period last year.

Transactions (April 2023 data)

There were 1,883 transactions in Canterbury during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 55% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Canterbury have fallen by 39.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -31.0% for the South East and -26.4% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

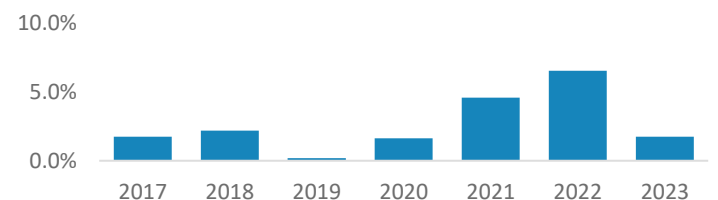
