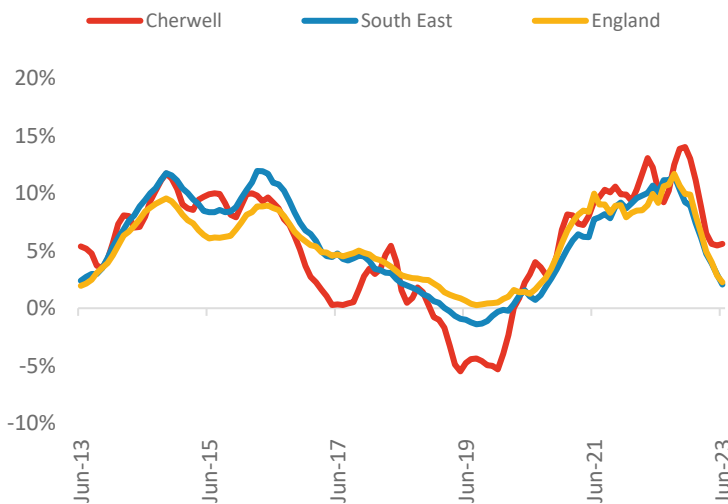

Annual Change in House Prices

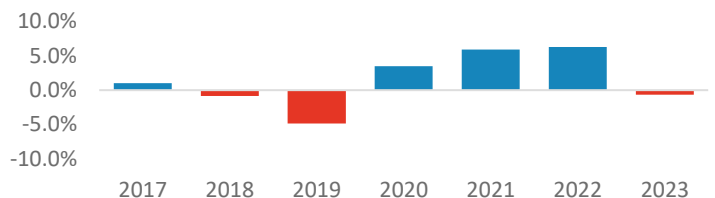


House prices in Cherwell grew by 5.6% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the South East grew by 2.1% over the same period.

Cherwell house prices are now 59.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +63.7% for the South East and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 0.7% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 6.3% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to June

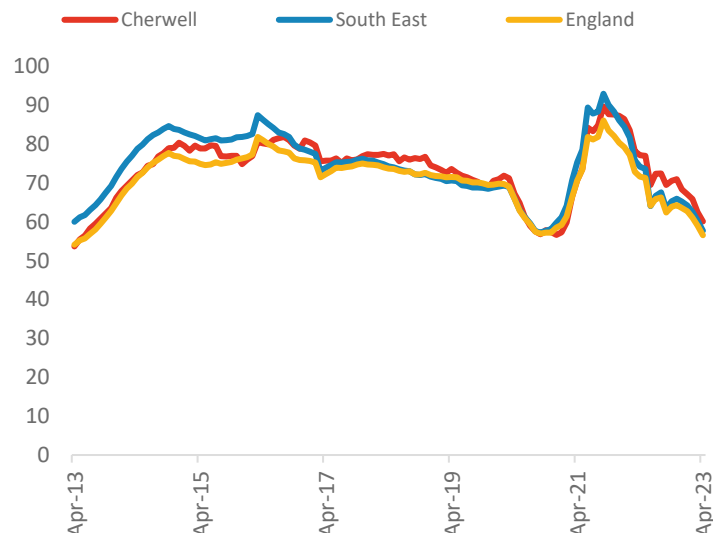


Transactions (April 2023 data)

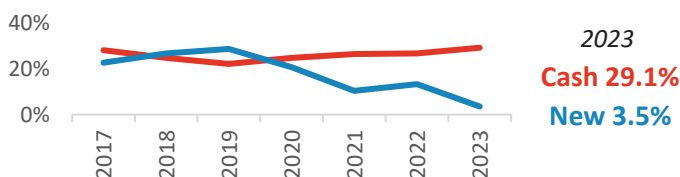
There were 2,151 transactions in Cherwell during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 60% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Cherwell have fallen by 25.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -31.0% for the South East and -26.4% for England.
