

#### **House Prices (June 2023 data)**

#### **Annual Change in House Prices**



House prices in Chesterfield grew by 0.7% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 3.0% over the same period.

Chesterfield house prices are now 38.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +55.3% for the East Midlands and +56.6% across England.


Local prices have fallen by 2.6% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 4.5% over the same period last year.


### **Transactions (April 2023 data)**

There were 1,368 transactions in Chesterfield during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 64% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100) levels.


Transactions in Chesterfield have fallen by 15.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.2% for the East Midlands and -26.4% for England.
