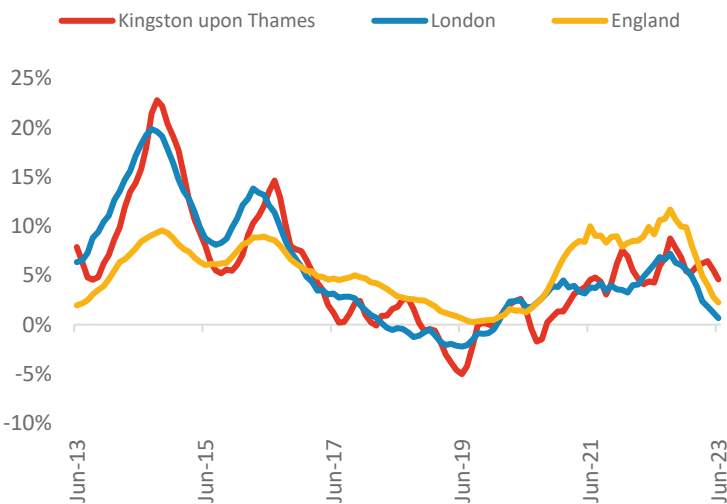

Annual Change in House Prices

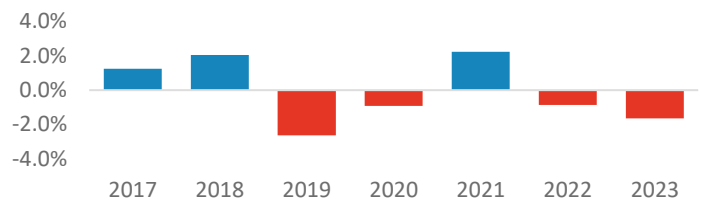


House prices in Kingston upon Thames grew by 4.6% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in London grew by 0.7% over the same period.

Kingston upon Thames house prices are now 70.0% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +77.1% for London and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 1.6% in 2023 so far, compared to a fall of 0.9% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to June

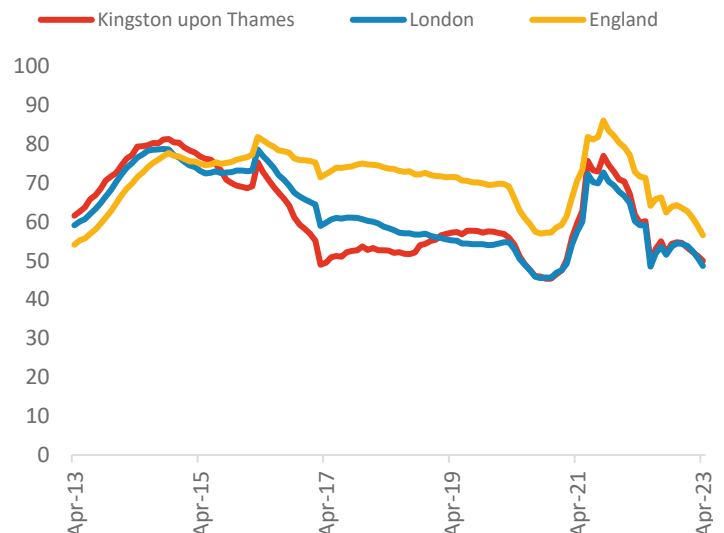


Transactions (April 2023 data)

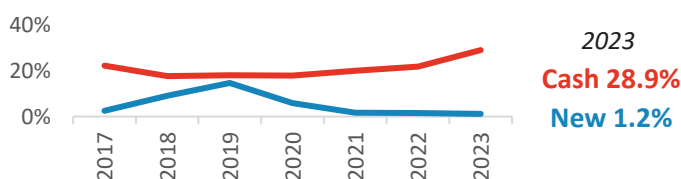
There were 1,900 transactions in Kingston upon Thames during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 50% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Kingston upon Thames have fallen by 37.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -36.4% for London and -26.4% for England.
