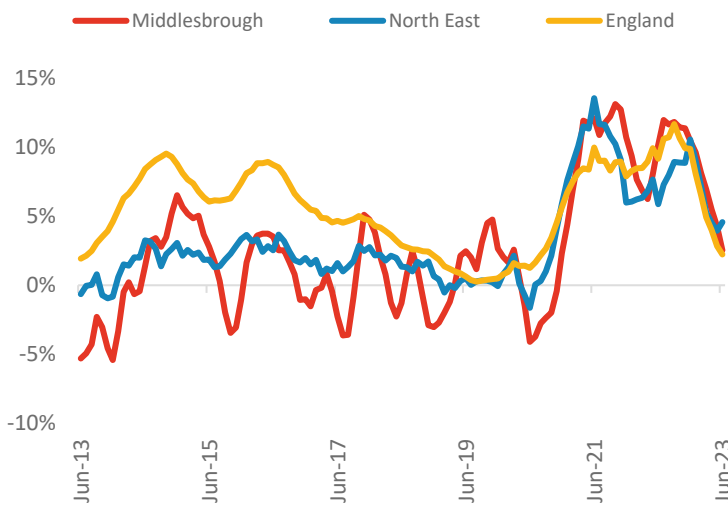

### House Prices (June 2023 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

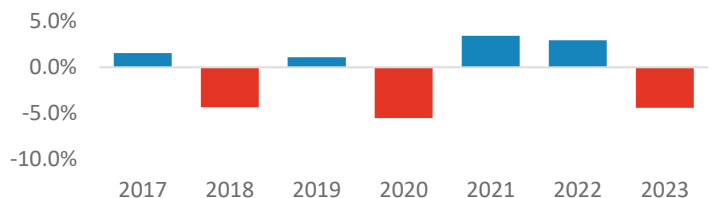


House prices in Middlesbrough grew by 2.5% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the North East grew by 4.6% over the same period.

Middlesbrough house prices are now 6.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +15.1% for the North East and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 4.4% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 2.9% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to June

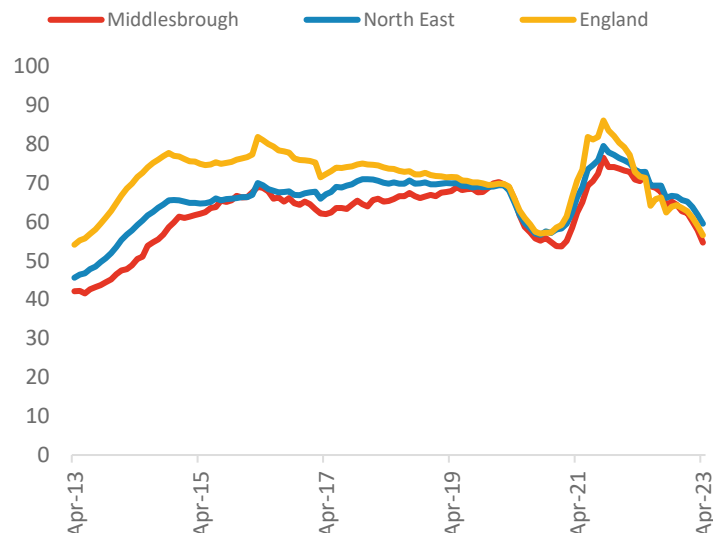


### Transactions (April 2023 data)

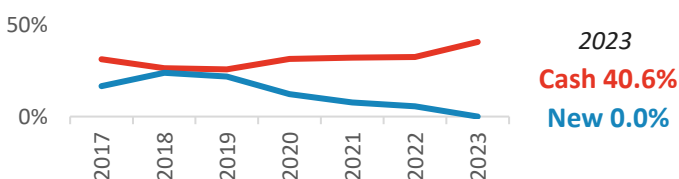
There were 1,586 transactions in Middlesbrough during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 55% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Middlesbrough have fallen by 10.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -9.2% for the North East and -26.4% for England.
