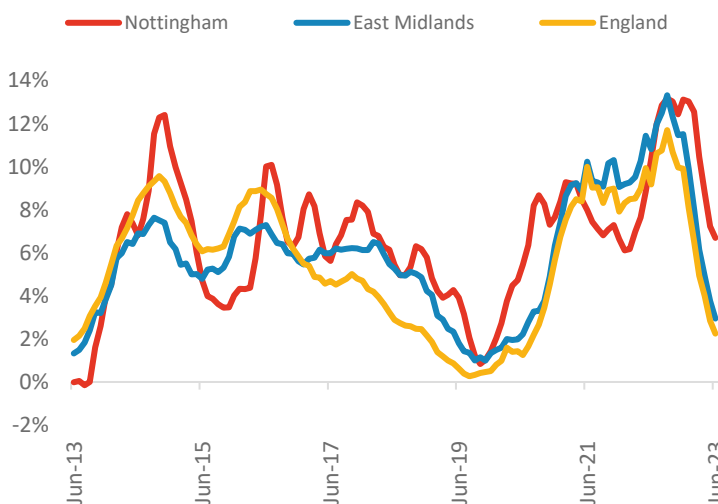

House Prices (June 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Nottingham grew by 6.7% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 3.0% over the same period.

Nottingham house prices are now 63.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +55.3% for the East Midlands and +56.6% across England.

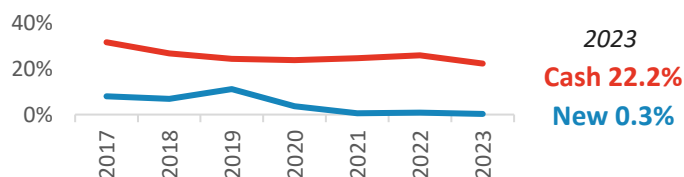
Local prices have fallen by 0.5% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 5.5% over the same period last year.

Transactions (April 2023 data)

There were 2,933 transactions in Nottingham during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 50% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Nottingham have fallen by 24.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.2% for the East Midlands and -26.4% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

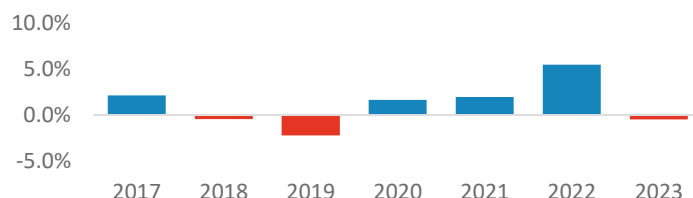
