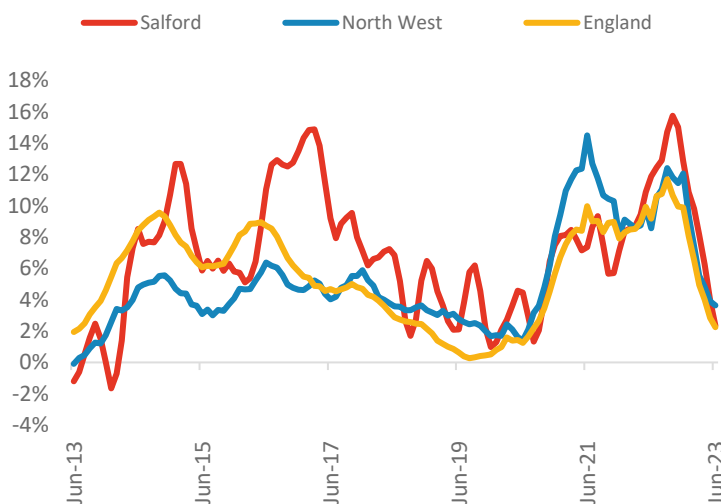

House Prices (June 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Salford grew by 2.3% in the 12 months to June 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 2.2% and prices in the North West grew by 3.6% over the same period.

Salford house prices are now 53.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +40.9% for the North West and +56.6% across England.

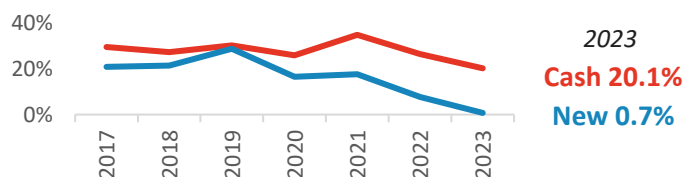
Local prices have fallen by 3.4% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 6.5% over the same period last year.

Transactions (April 2023 data)

There were 3,058 transactions in Salford during the 12 months to April 2023. This is 59% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Salford have fallen by 23.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -15.0% for the North West and -26.4% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

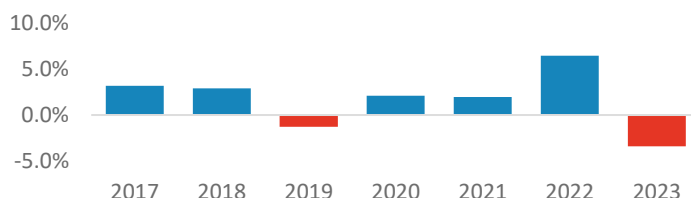
