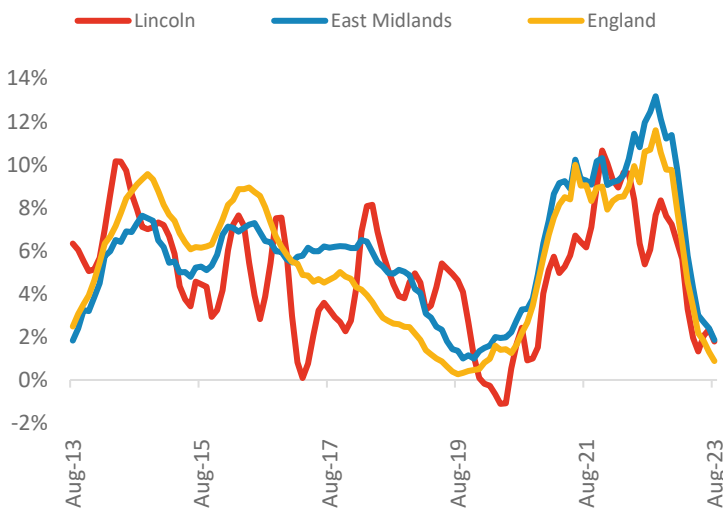

House Prices (August 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Lincoln grew by 1.8% in the 12 months to August 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 0.9% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 1.9% over the same period.

Lincoln house prices are now 42.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +57.6% for the East Midlands and +58.4% across England.

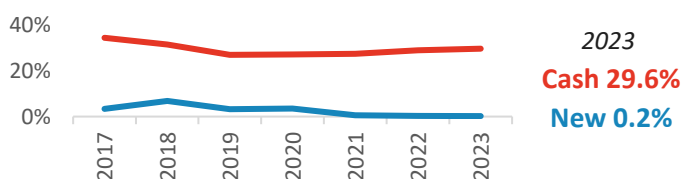
Local prices have fallen by 2.7% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 2.5% over the same period last year.

Transactions (June 2023 data)

There were 1,209 transactions in Lincoln during the 12 months to June 2023. This is 48% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Lincoln have fallen by 33.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -29.6% for the East Midlands and -29.7% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

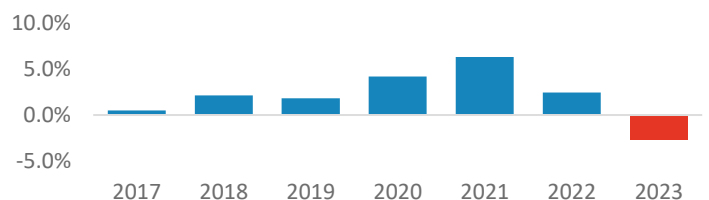
