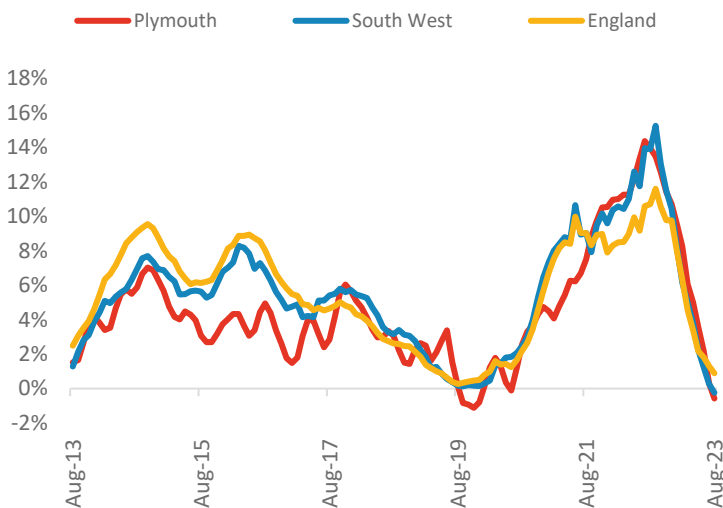

Annual Change in House Prices

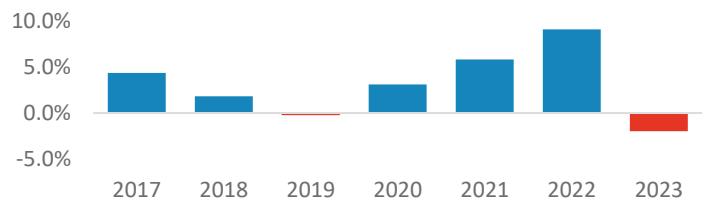


House prices in Plymouth fell by 0.6% in the 12 months to August 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 0.9% and prices in the South West fell by 0.2% over the same period.

Plymouth house prices are now 37.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +53.5% for the South West and +58.4% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 2.0% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 9.1% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to August

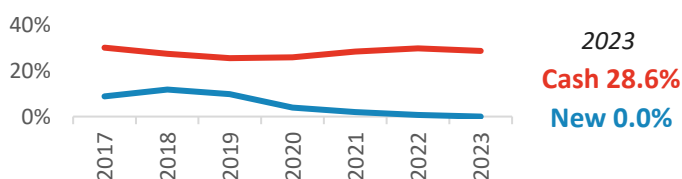


Transactions (June 2023 data)

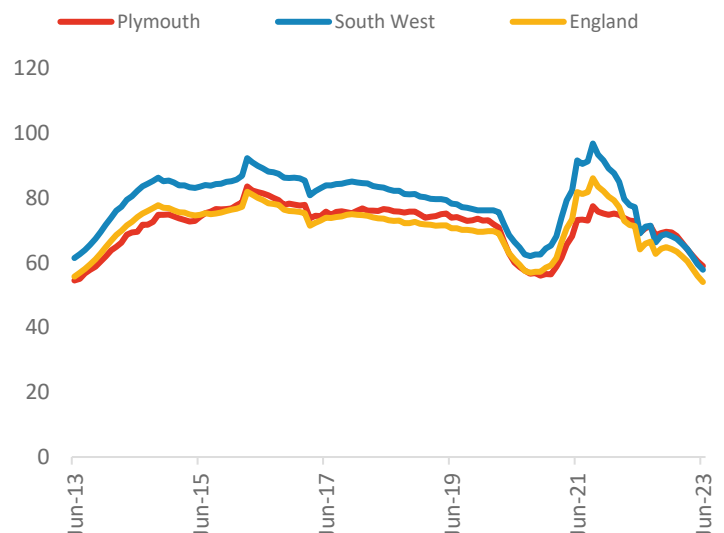
There were 3,465 transactions in Plymouth during the 12 months to June 2023. This is 59% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Plymouth have fallen by 21.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -32.3% for the South West and -29.7% for England.
