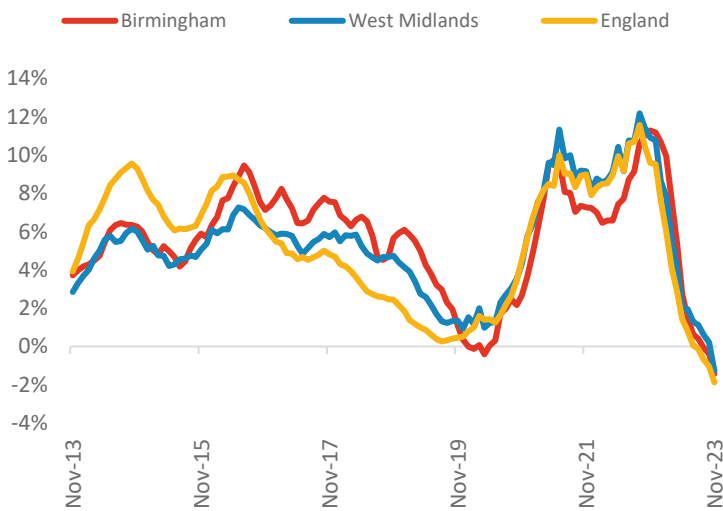

House Prices (November 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Birmingham fell by 1.4% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the West Midlands fell by 1.3% over the same period.

Birmingham house prices are now 54.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +50.9% for the West Midlands and +56.6% across England.

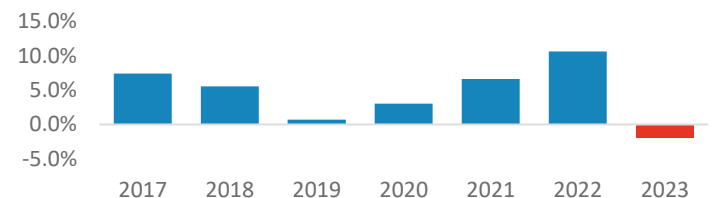
Local prices have fallen by 1.9% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 10.7% over the same period in 2022.

Transactions (September 2023 data)

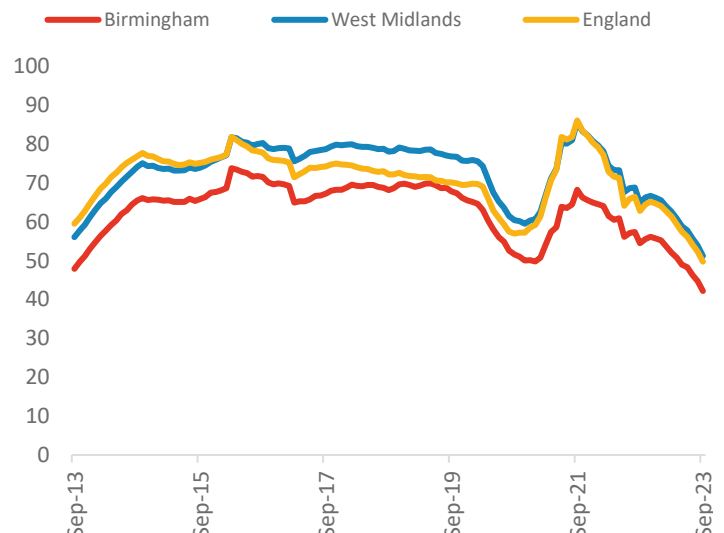
There were 8,244 transactions in Birmingham during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 42% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Birmingham have fallen by 35.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -31.2% for the West Midlands and -35.3% for England.

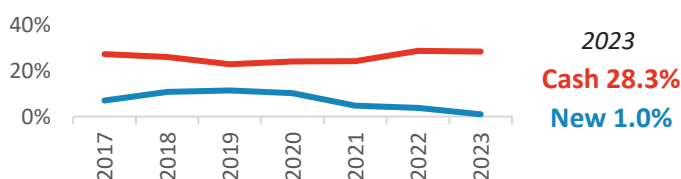
Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November
