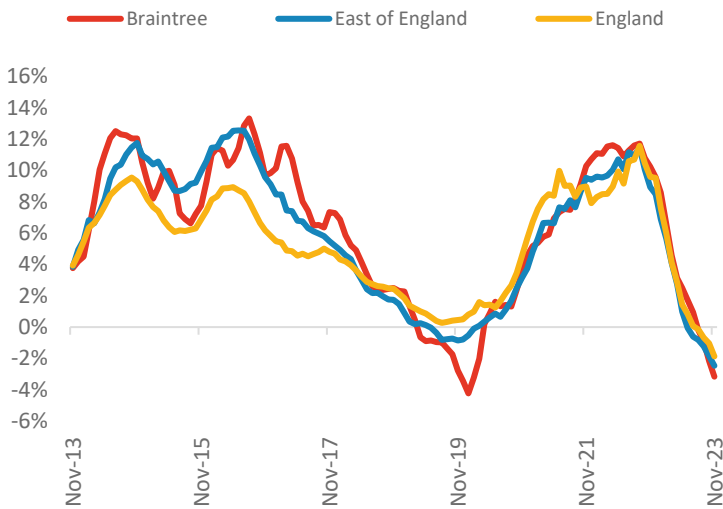

Annual Change in House Prices

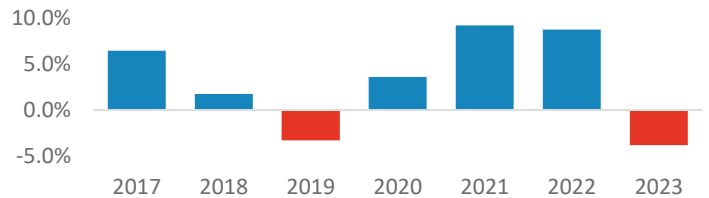


House prices in Braintree fell by 3.2% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the East of England fell by 2.5% over the same period.

Braintree house prices are now 64.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +66.6% for the East of England and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 3.9% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 8.8% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

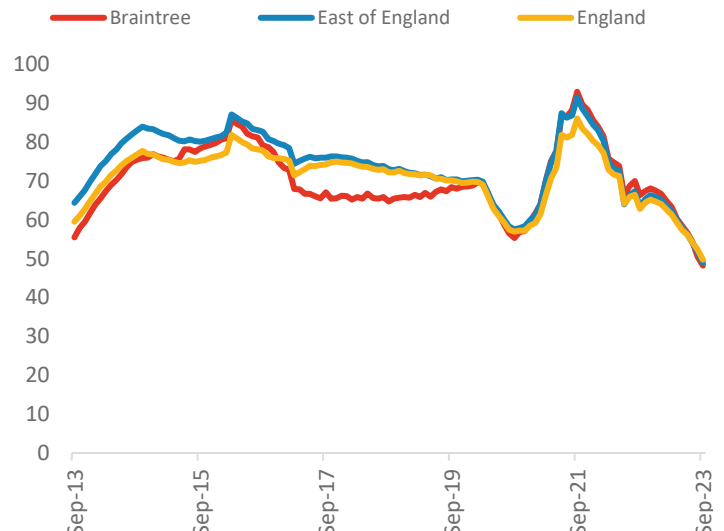


Transactions (September 2023 data)

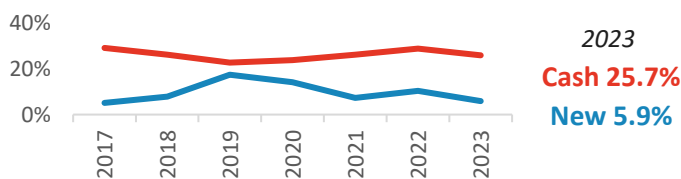
There were 1,776 transactions in Braintree during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 48% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Braintree have fallen by 37.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -41.3% for the East of England and -35.3% for England.
