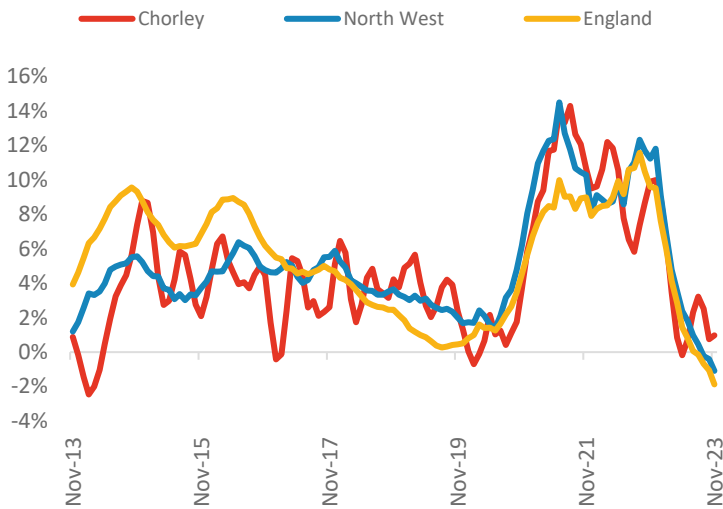

Annual Change in House Prices

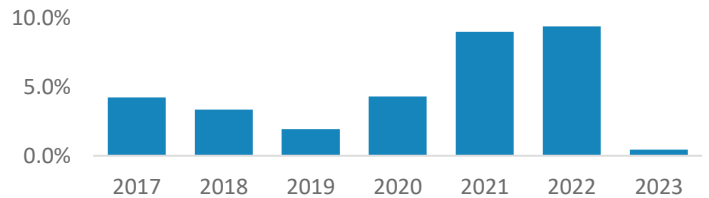


House prices in Chorley grew by 1.0% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the North West fell by 1.1% over the same period.

Chorley house prices are now 38.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +41.7% for the North West and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.4% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 9.4% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

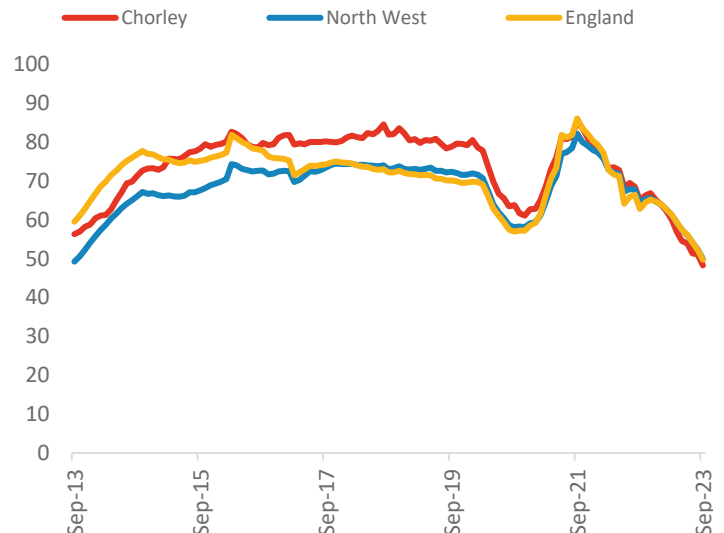


Transactions (September 2023 data)

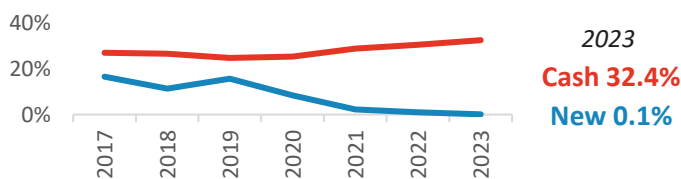
There were 1,269 transactions in Chorley during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 48% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Chorley have fallen by 34.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -25.3% for the North West and -35.3% for England.
