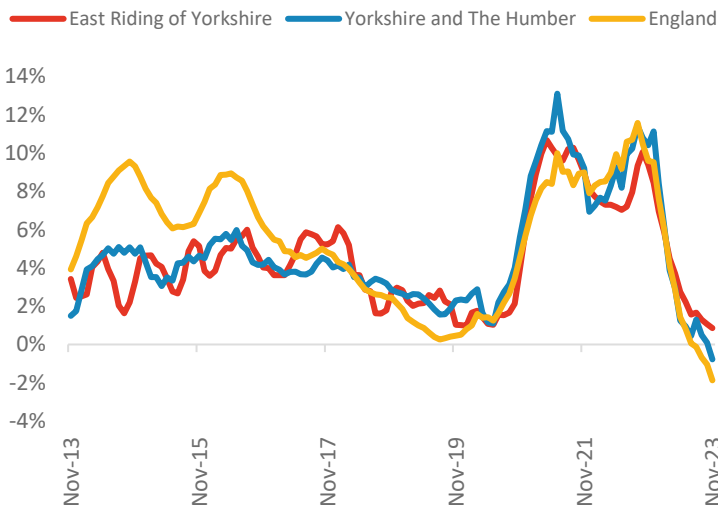

### House Prices (November 2023 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

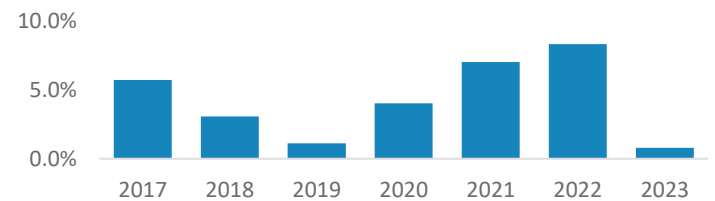


House prices in East Riding of Yorkshire grew by 0.9% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber fell by 0.8% over the same period.

East Riding of Yorkshire house prices are now 37.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +39.3% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.8% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 8.4% over the same period in 2022.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

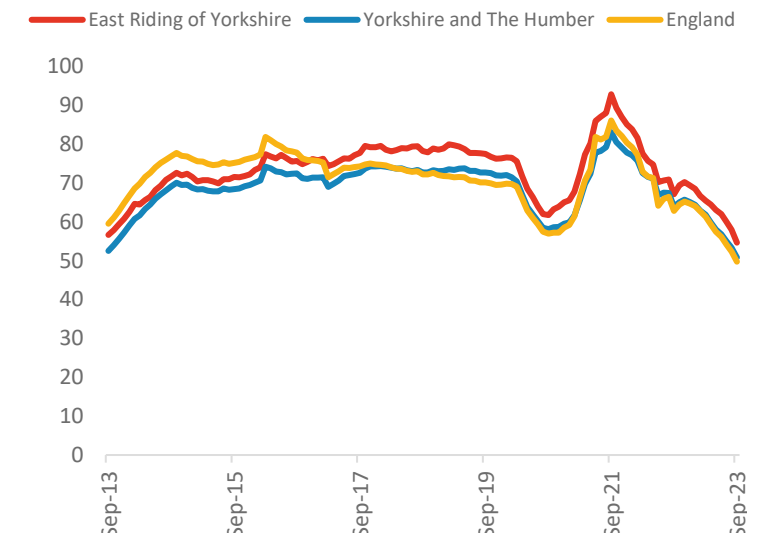


### Transactions (September 2023 data)

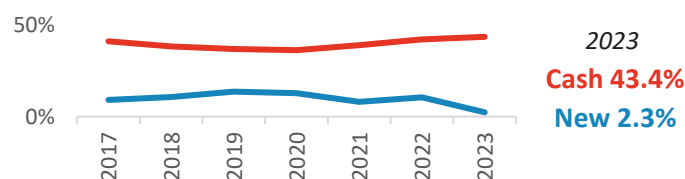
There were 4,712 transactions in East Riding of Yorkshire during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 55% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in East Riding of Yorkshire have fallen by 24.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -27.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -35.3% for England.
