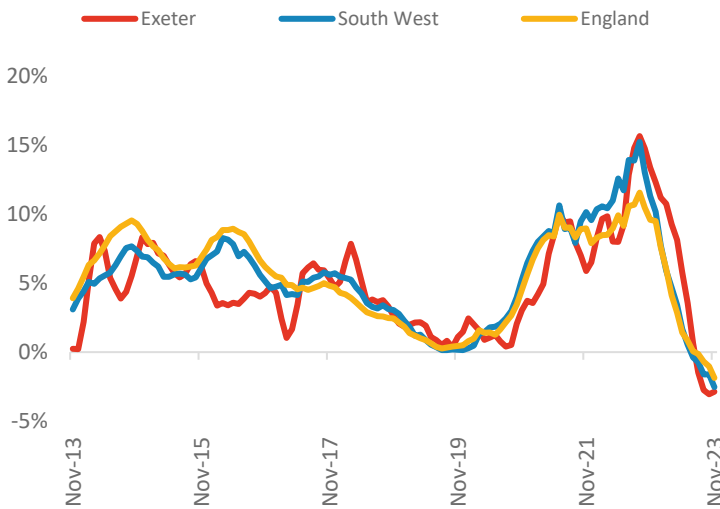

### House Prices (November 2023 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

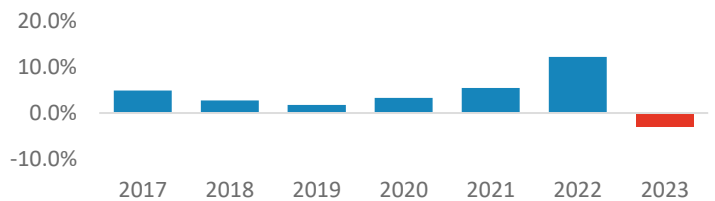


House prices in Exeter fell by 2.9% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the South West fell by 2.5% over the same period.

Exeter house prices are now 53.0% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +53.1% for the South West and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 2.9% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 12.3% over the same period in 2022.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

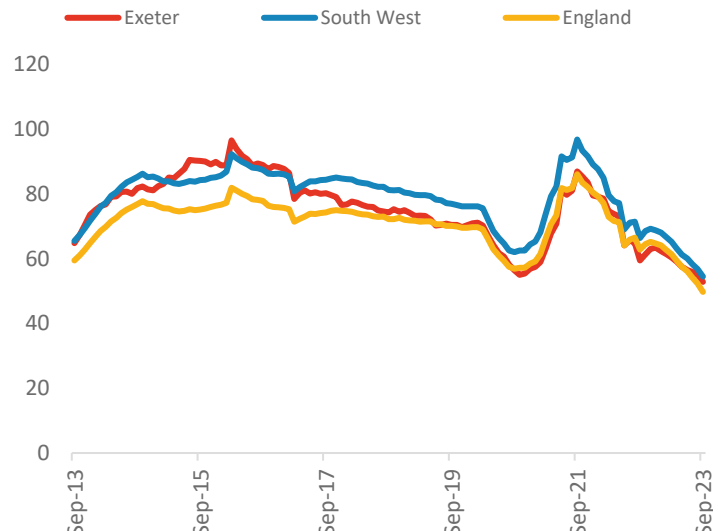


### Transactions (September 2023 data)

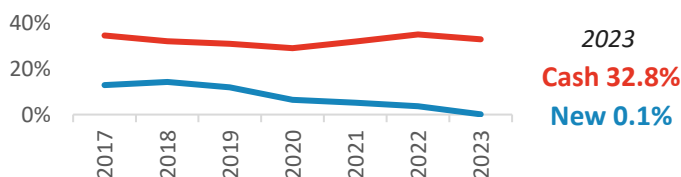
There were 1,443 transactions in Exeter during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 53% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Exeter have fallen by 34.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -36.2% for the South West and -35.3% for England.
