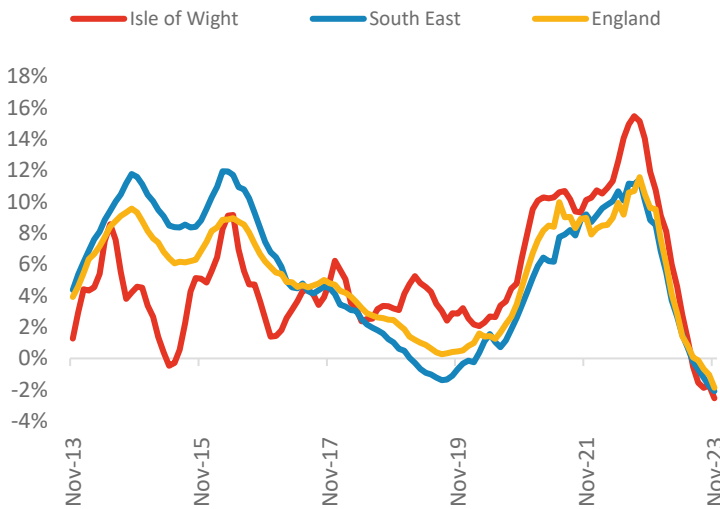

Annual Change in House Prices

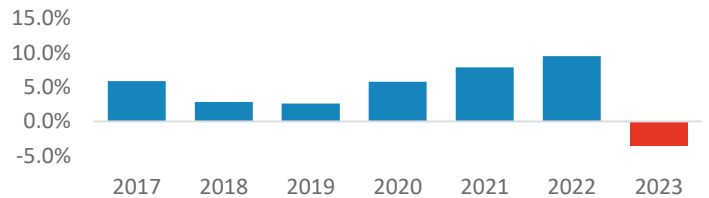


House prices in Isle of Wight fell by 2.5% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the South East fell by 2.1% over the same period.

Isle of Wight house prices are now 45.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +62.7% for the South East and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 3.6% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 9.5% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

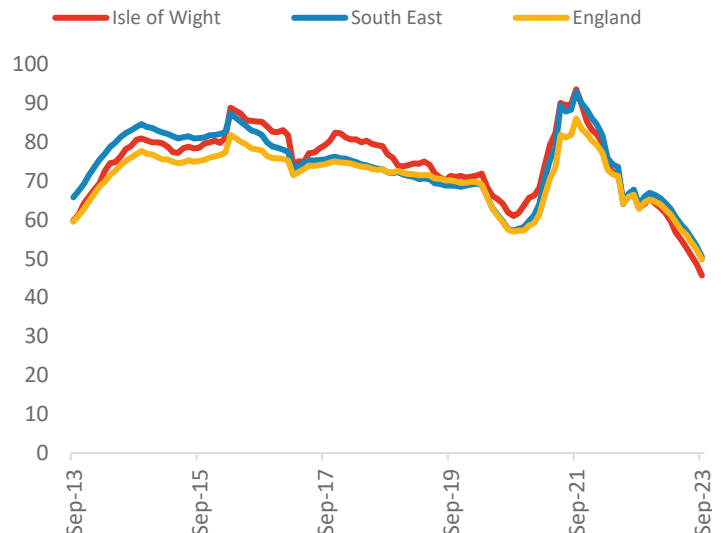


Transactions (September 2023 data)

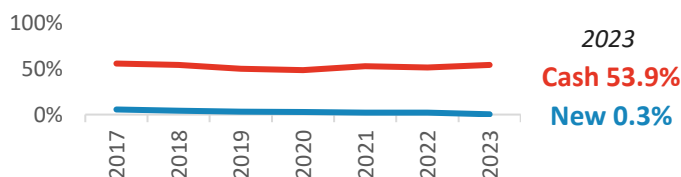
There were 1,767 transactions in Isle of Wight during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 46% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Isle of Wight have fallen by 42.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -39.7% for the South East and -35.3% for England.
