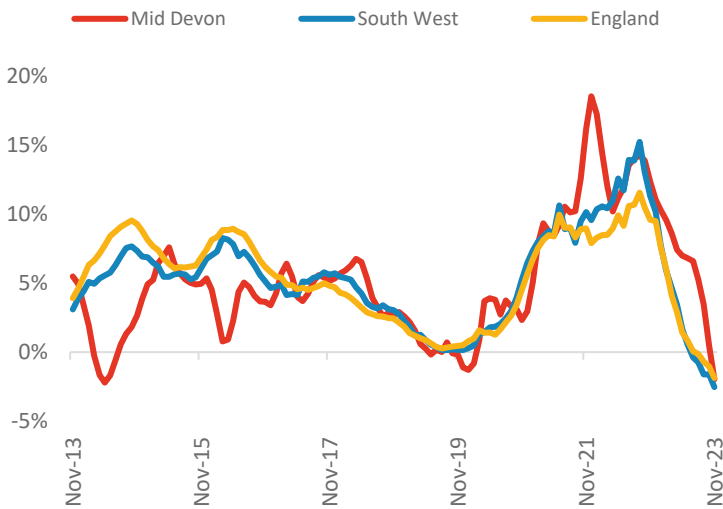

Annual Change in House Prices

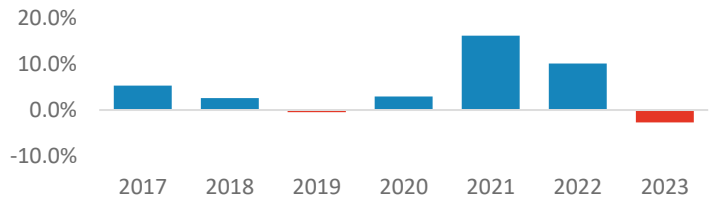


House prices in Mid Devon fell by 2.0% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the South West fell by 2.5% over the same period.

Mid Devon house prices are now 43.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +53.1% for the South West and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 2.7% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 10.2% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

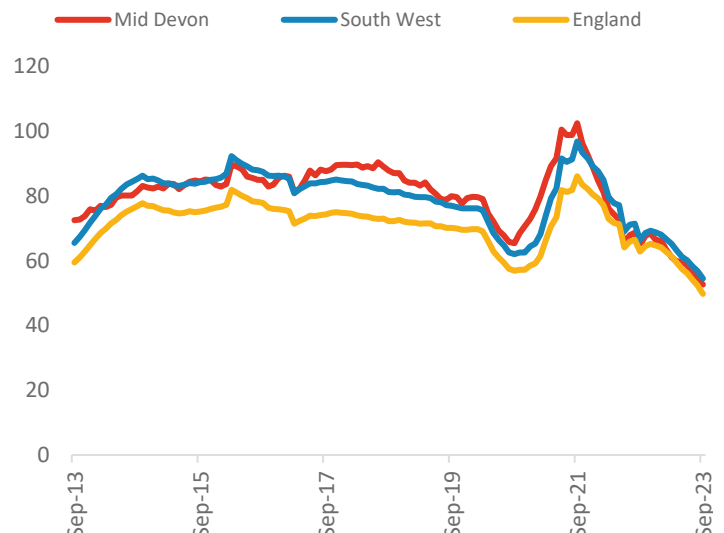


Transactions (September 2023 data)

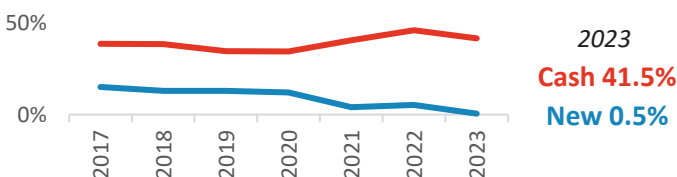
There were 876 transactions in Mid Devon during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 53% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Mid Devon have fallen by 36.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -36.2% for the South West and -35.3% for England.
