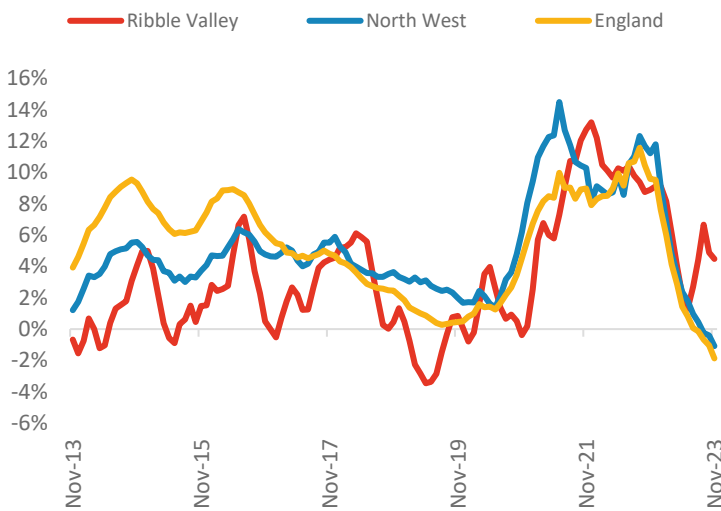

Annual Change in House Prices

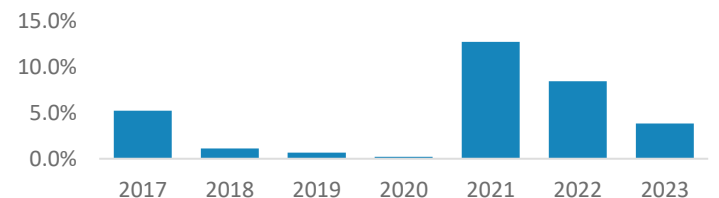


House prices in Ribble Valley grew by 4.5% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the North West fell by 1.1% over the same period.

Ribble Valley house prices are now 26.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +41.7% for the North West and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.9% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 8.5% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

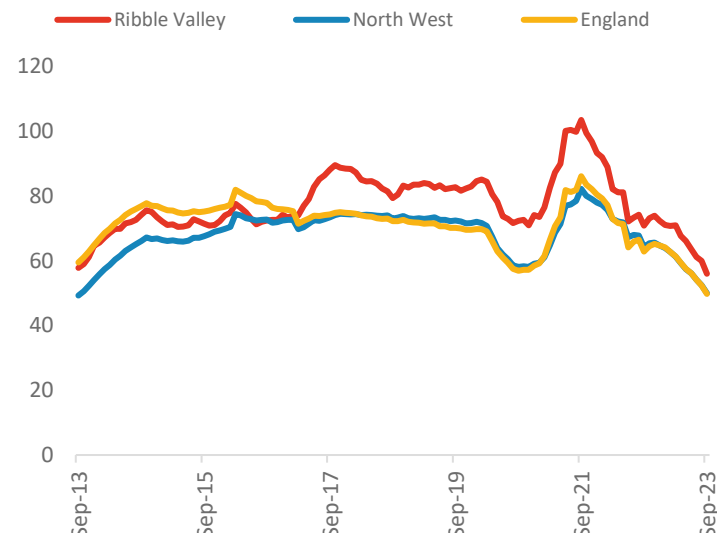


Transactions (September 2023 data)

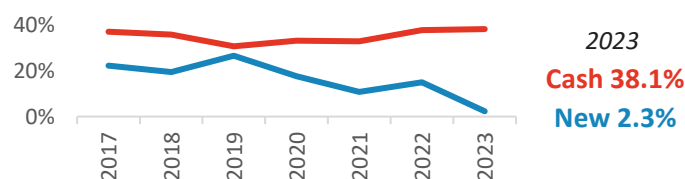
There were 772 transactions in Ribble Valley during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 56% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Ribble Valley have fallen by 23.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -25.3% for the North West and -35.3% for England.
