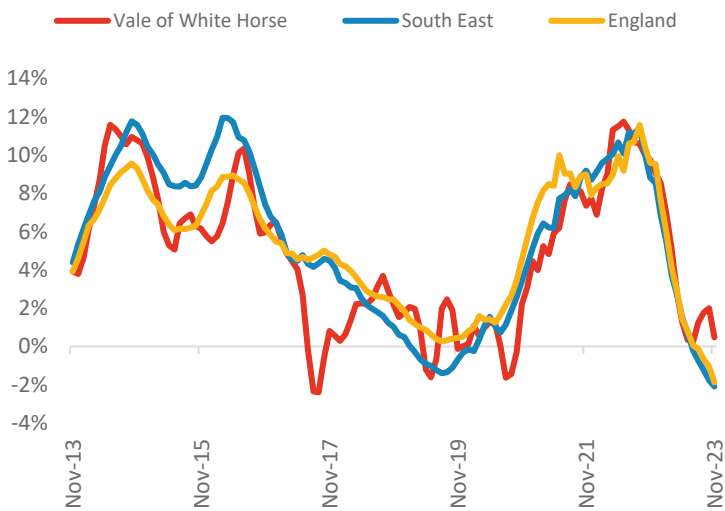

Annual Change in House Prices

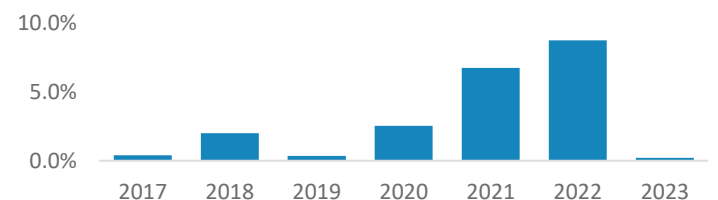


House prices in Vale of White Horse grew by 0.5% in the 12 months to November 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the South East fell by 2.1% over the same period.

Vale of White Horse house prices are now 59.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +62.7% for the South East and +56.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.2% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 8.8% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to November

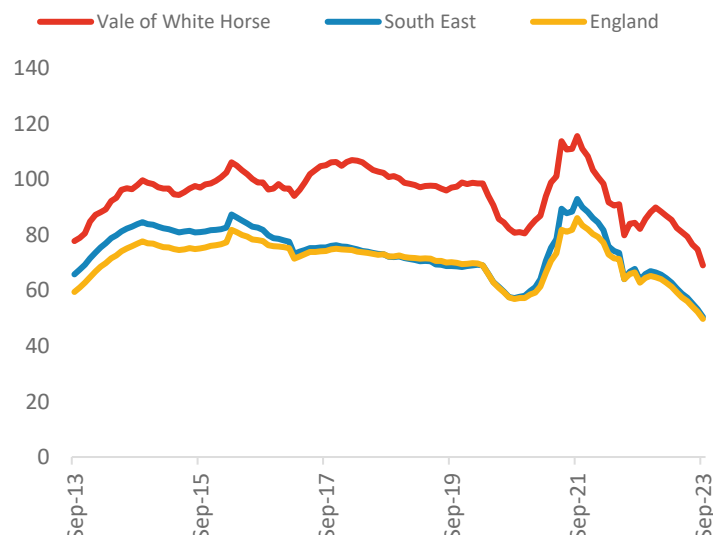


Transactions (September 2023 data)

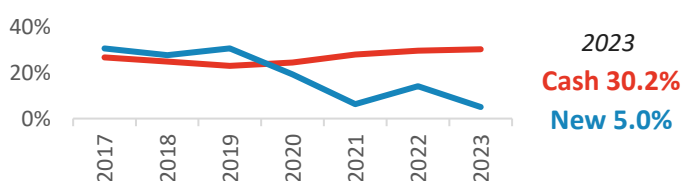
There were 1,644 transactions in Vale of White Horse during the 12 months to September 2023. This is 69% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Vale of White Horse have fallen by 29.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -39.7% for the South East and -35.3% for England.
