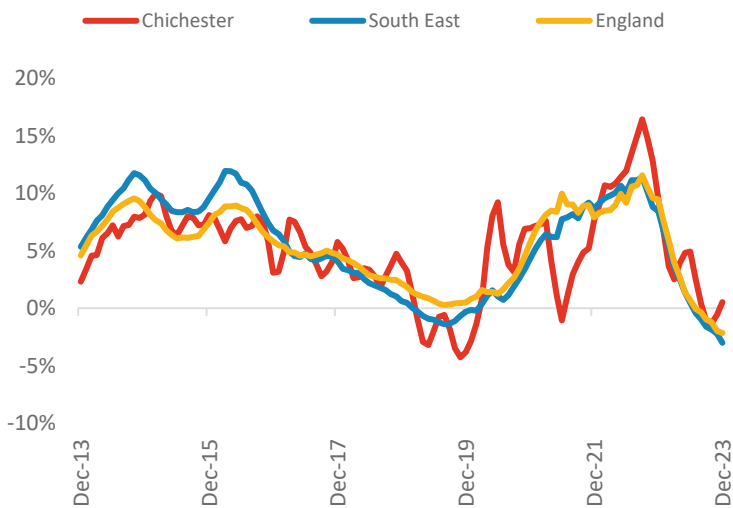

House Prices (December 2023 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Chichester grew by 0.5% in the 12 months to December 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 2.2% and prices in the South East fell by 3.0% over the same period.

Chichester house prices are now 65.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +60.9% for the South East and +55.8% across England.

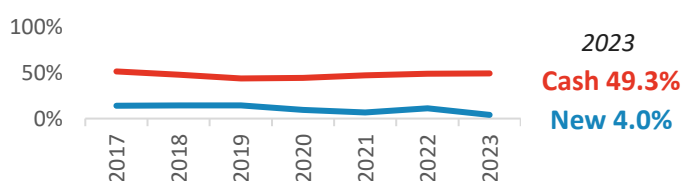
Local prices have grown by 0.5% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 9.6% over the same period in 2022.

Transactions (October 2023 data)

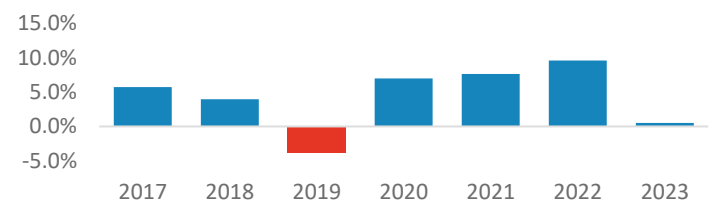
There were 1,431 transactions in Chichester during the 12 months to October 2023. This is 57% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Chichester have fallen by 39.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -41.5% for the South East and -36.8% for England.

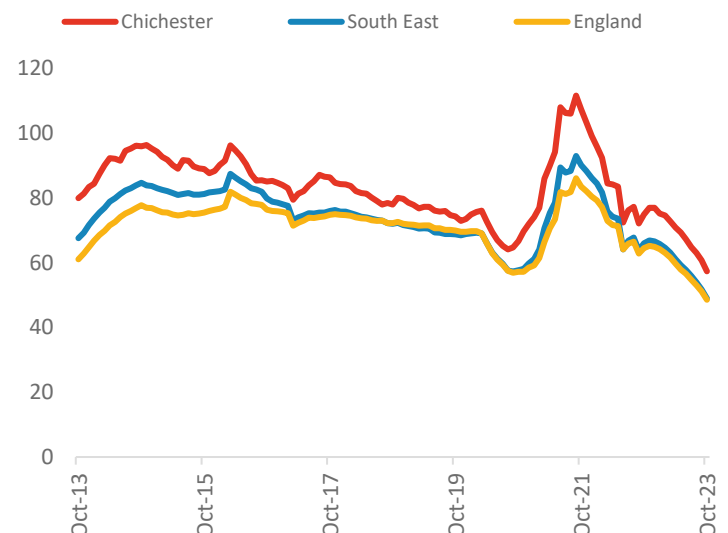
Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*
