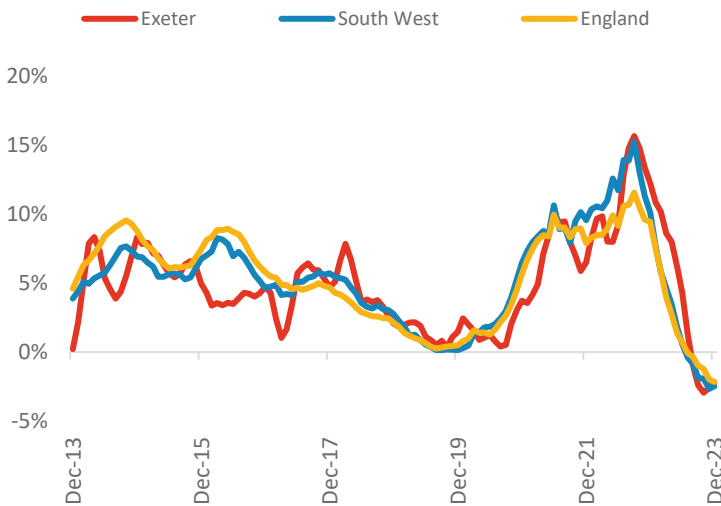

Annual Change in House Prices

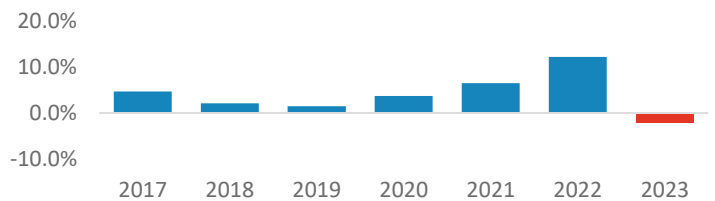


House prices in Exeter fell by 2.2% in the 12 months to December 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 2.2% and prices in the South West fell by 2.5% over the same period.

Exeter house prices are now 54.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +52.0% for the South West and +55.8% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 2.2% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 12.3% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

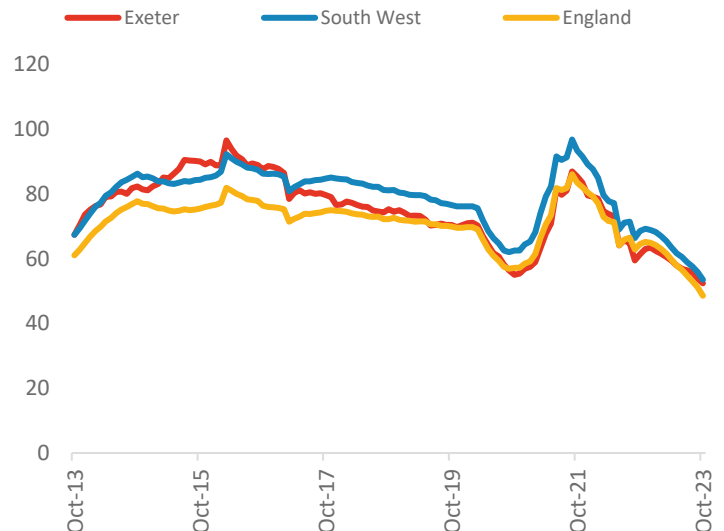


Transactions (October 2023 data)

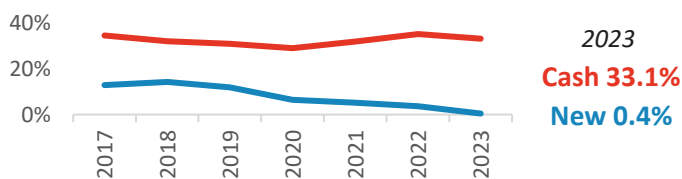
There were 1,431 transactions in Exeter during the 12 months to October 2023. This is 52% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Exeter have fallen by 35.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -37.3% for the South West and -36.8% for England.
