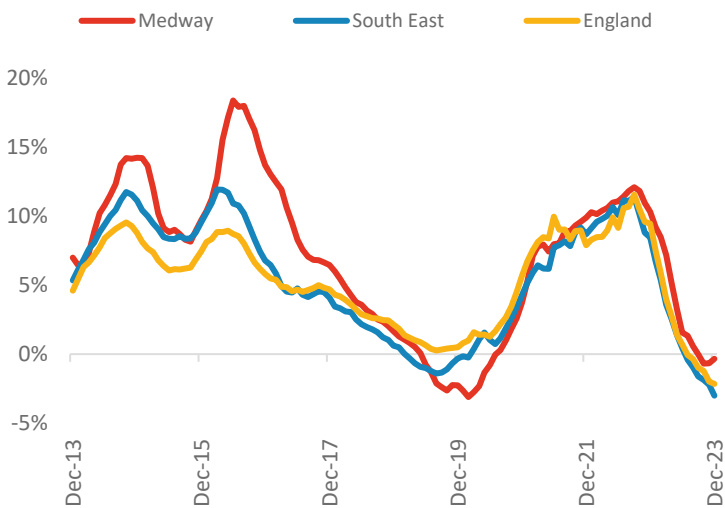

Annual Change in House Prices

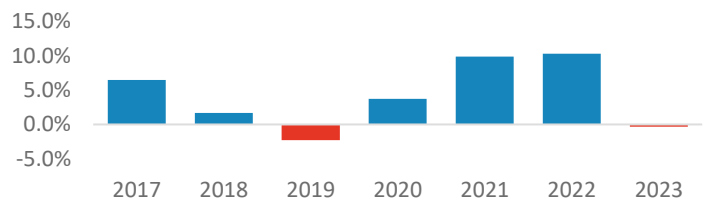


House prices in Medway fell by 0.3% in the 12 months to December 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 2.2% and prices in the South East fell by 3.0% over the same period.

Medway house prices are now 78.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +60.9% for the South East and +55.8% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 0.3% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 10.3% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

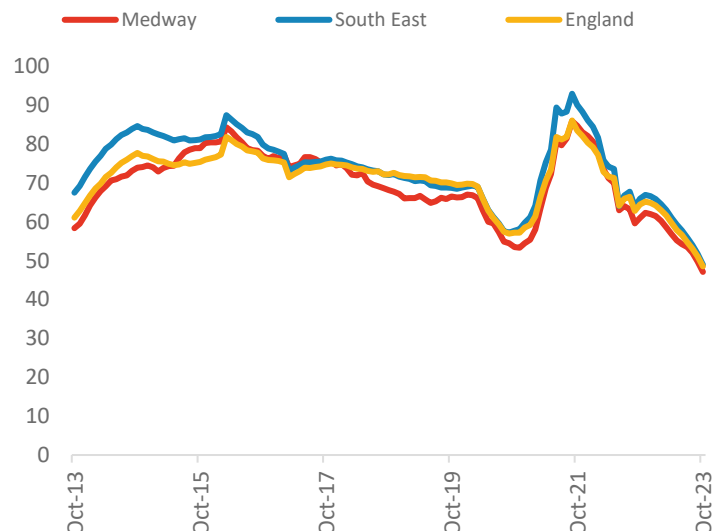


Transactions (October 2023 data)

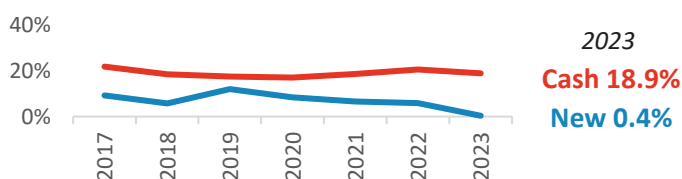
There were 2,896 transactions in Medway during the 12 months to October 2023. This is 47% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Medway have fallen by 36.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -41.5% for the South East and -36.8% for England.
