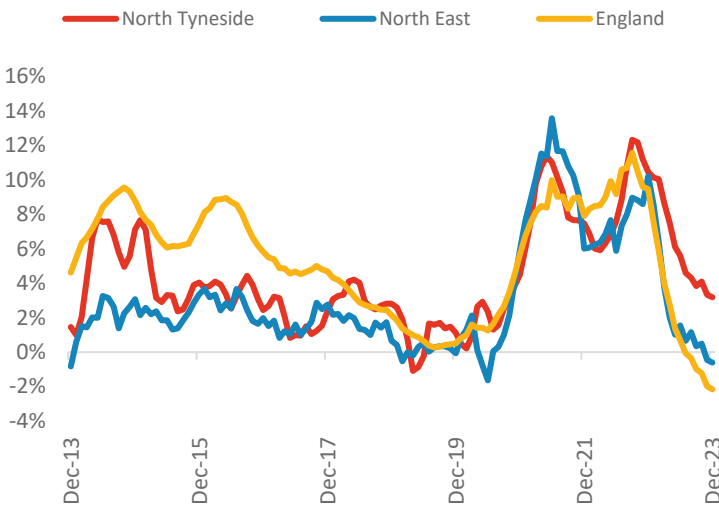

Annual Change in House Prices

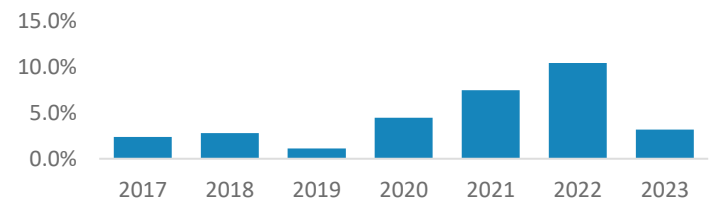


House prices in North Tyneside grew by 3.2% in the 12 months to December 2023 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 2.2% and prices in the North East fell by 0.6% over the same period.

North Tyneside house prices are now 37.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +14.7% for the North East and +55.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.2% in 2023 so far, compared to growth of 10.5% over the same period in 2022.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to December

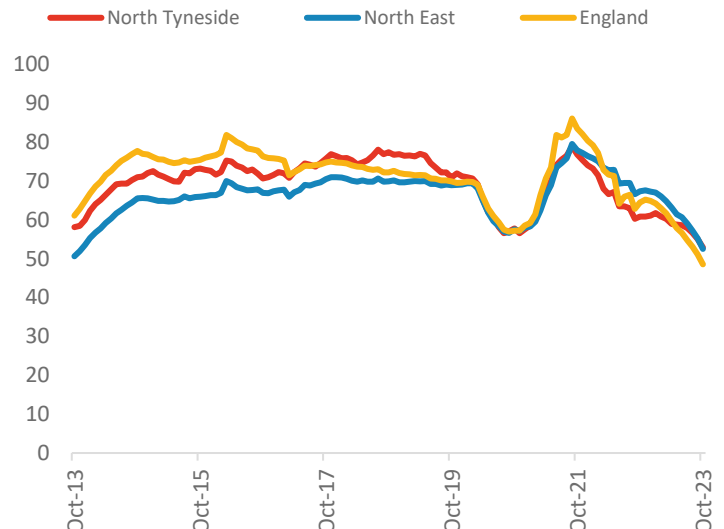


Transactions (October 2023 data)

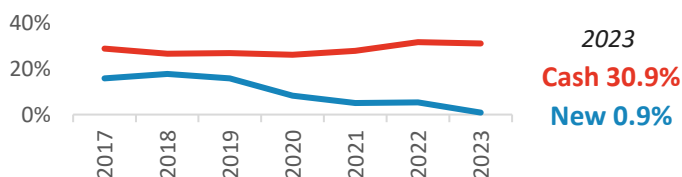
There were 2,622 transactions in North Tyneside during the 12 months to October 2023. This is 53% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in North Tyneside have fallen by 26.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -19.9% for the North East and -36.8% for England.
