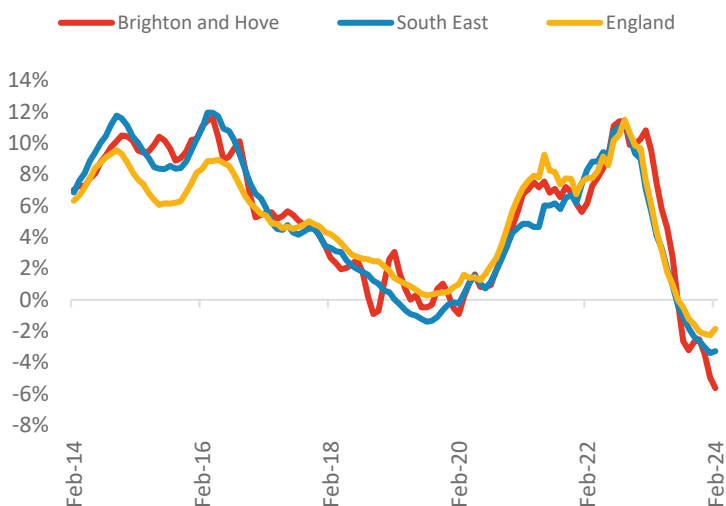

House Prices (February 2024 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Brighton and Hove fell by 5.6% in the 12 months to February 2024 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the South East fell by 3.3% over the same period.

Brighton and Hove house prices are now 65.4% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +55.8% for the South East and +52.9% across England.

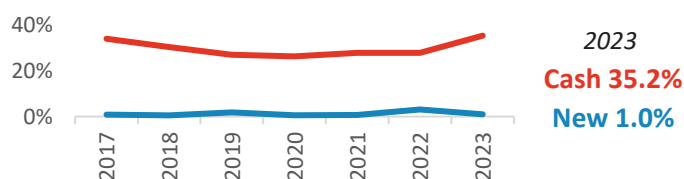
Local prices have fallen by 1.1% in 2024 so far, compared to growth of 1.2% over the same period in 2023.

Transactions (December 2023 data)

There were 2,751 transactions in Brighton and Hove during the 12 months to December 2023. This is 37% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Brighton and Hove have fallen by 51.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -46.1% for the South East and -41.2% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

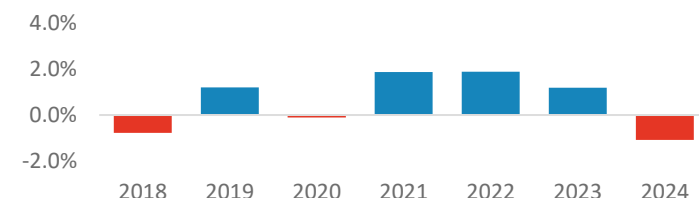
