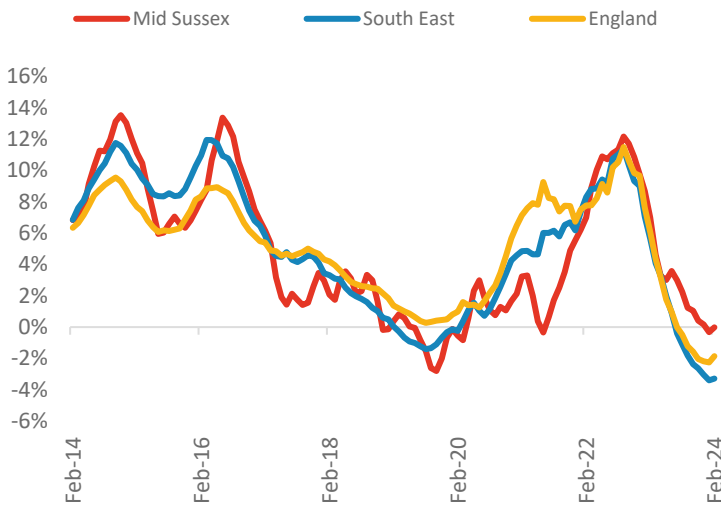

House Prices (February 2024 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Mid Sussex stayed the same in the 12 months to February 2024 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the South East fell by 3.3% over the same period.

Mid Sussex house prices are now 54.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +55.8% for the South East and +52.9% across England.

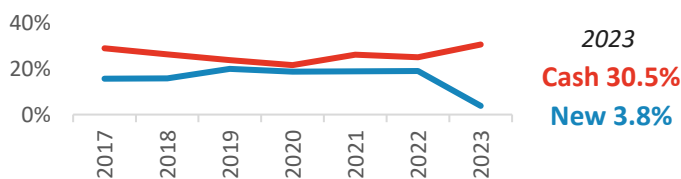
Local prices have stayed flat in 2024 so far, compared to growth of 0.2% over the same period in 2023.

Transactions (December 2023 data)

There were 1,692 transactions in Mid Sussex during the 12 months to December 2023. This is 53% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Mid Sussex have fallen by 45.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -46.1% for the South East and -41.2% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

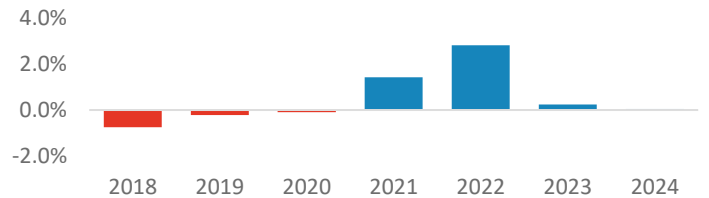
